

Wyoming Republican Party – County Convention
Resolution on Protecting Unborn Life Through Constitutional and Lawful Means

WHEREAS, The Wyoming Republican Party affirms the inherent value of human life and the moral duty of government to protect the unborn; and

WHEREAS, The authority to regulate abortion now rests with the states following the U.S. Supreme Court’s decision in Dobbs v. Jackson Women’s Health Organization; and

WHEREAS, Recent decisions of the Wyoming Supreme Court have held that existing abortion bans conflict with the Wyoming Constitution as currently written; and

WHEREAS, Legislation that is predictably struck down by the courts fails to protect unborn life and weakens conservative credibility; and

WHEREAS, The rule of law requires that constitutional obstacles be addressed directly rather than ignored;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Wyoming Republican Party reaffirms its commitment to reducing and preventing abortion in Wyoming through lawful, effective, and durable policy; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Party supports constitutional clarification, including amendment if necessary, to ensure that protections for “health care decisions” are not construed to include elective abortion; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Party urges Republican legislators to prioritize abortion regulations that can survive judicial review, including informed consent requirements, legitimate health and safety standards, gestational limits with clear medical exceptions, and policies that support women who carry pregnancies to term; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Party encourages responsible civic engagement in judicial retention elections and rejects rhetoric that undermines the legitimacy of Wyoming’s courts.
