Effective: September 2026 Intake onwards

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1. Non-Academic Fees

Admin and Lab fees must be paid with the 1st instalment.

2nd Instalment = Total fee minus 1st Instalment.

All fees are in EGP for national students. International students pay GBP 13,500 (all programmes), should be paid only in GBP or equivalent of USD.

4. Module Retake Fees

- Students pay the number of credit hours multiplied by the charge per hour as per the announced tuition fees in the repeating year.
- After the first day of classes, no refund is approved.

5.0 Transfer Policy

5.1 Internal Transfers (Change of Major within UH-GAF)

- Starting from L5, internal transfer from Pharmaceutical Science to M-Pharm is accepted provided the student satisfies the academic and English level criteria; the fee difference between the two programmes must be paid retroactively based on tuition fees fixed at the year of enrolment.
- Internal transfer after IFP from Pharmaceutical Science to Physiotherapy is no longer applicable due to differing modules.

5.2 External Transfers (From Another University)

- In the case of approved academic transcript equivalent to IFP at UH-GAF, the student will pay the standard fees plus EGP 10,000 (academic assessment fee). All other non-academic fees also apply.

6. Tuition Fees – International Students

The tuition fee for international students is GBP 13,500 for all programmes. International students may only pay in GBP or any other foreign currency at the prevailing global exchange rate at the time of settlement.

8. Direct Entry – Fees & Scholarships

Direct Entry students join at undergraduate levels above IFP. The following terms apply:

1. Direct Entry standard fees are 10% higher than the standard IFP fees for the same programme.
2. Only ONE merit scholarship category is available for Direct Entry students (equivalent to the standard IFP fees level).
3. M-Pharm, Physiotherapy and all Engineering programmes are NOT applicable for Direct Entry.
4. Direct Entry students may be required to sign a consent form acknowledging they may not be entitled to join a syndicate or supreme council in Egypt.

9. Payment Terms, Transportation, Refund & Withdrawal Policies

9.1 Payment Deadlines

- AB Cycle: 1st instalment by 15 August 2026; 2nd instalment by 31 December 2026.
- BC Cycle: 1st instalment by 31 December 2026; 2nd instalment by 31 March 2027.
- Tuition fees are subject to an annual increase of up to 15%.
- Non-academic fees and lab fees are subject to annual review.
- **Late Payment Penalties:** 2% (up to 3 weeks overdue), 5% (3–6 weeks overdue), 7% (6–10 weeks overdue), and 10% (more than 10 weeks overdue), calculated on the outstanding balance.
- In case of any unsettled fees, all enrollment certificates and requested documents will be placed on hold until full settlement.
- Three weeks after the payment deadline, should the outstanding fees remain unsettled, further actions will be enforced. These may include, but are not limited to, deactivation of Canvas access, denial of entry to campus, and dismissal from the University.
- Any cases falling under this remit will be formally referred to the University's legal counsel to initiate appropriate action for the recovery of outstanding fees.

9.2 Early Bird Refund Policy

The Early Bird deposit is NON-REFUNDABLE except in the following cases (50% refund only):

- Applicant provides evidence of recent English results below admissions requirements.
- Applicants fail to meet the minimum secondary school average required for their major.
- Refund request must be submitted before 20 September (AB intake) or 2 January (BC intake).
- Change of major is permitted once during the admissions period and before classes start; the Early Bird discount remains valid.
- No refund after final acceptance or in cases of no-show.

9.3 New and Returning Students Withdrawal Policy

- Withdrawal before the start of classes: total fees may be refunded excluding 40,000 EGP (or GBP 1,350 for international students).
- Suspension after the 1st installment deadline, an applicable fee of 40,000 EGP (or GBP 1,350 for international students), after start of classes all academic year fee would be due.
- After the start of classes: no refund is approved.
- Students awarded a merit scholarship who withdraw after completing one or more semesters will be required to repay the full value of all scholarship amounts received throughout their period of enrolment at the University.
- Students who received forced suspension decisions as a result of Academic misconduct or Non-Academic misconduct will NOT be exempted from paying their financial dues for the whole academic year regardless of the period of the forced suspension.
- Fees paid cannot be transferred to another student (sibling or otherwise).
- A deposit paid by a student who did not enrol may be transferred to the following session of the same academic year (same student only).
- Any other deposits or payments (external registration, books, field trips, transportation) are non-refundable.

9.4 Transportation and Dorms payment terms and policy.

- The transportation and dorms fees are charged as a one-time annual subscription covering the full academic year.
- Exceptionally, only **"transportation"** payment may be made in two installments: 60% with the first installment and 40% with the second installment.
- The subscription remains binding for the full academic year; even if the service is not used in the second or first semester, the second installment remains payable in full. Semester-only subscriptions are not permitted.
- Fees, once paid, are strictly non-refundable and non-transferable, regardless of whether the service is used or not.

10. Scholarships & Discounts

The percentage of any other scholarships and discounts is deducted from the remaining tuition fees after applying the Merit Category scheme. All scholarships and discounts are applied in the SECOND instalment only.

10.1 Academic Merit Scholarship Scheme (GPA-Based)

Students who complete 120 credit hours in the academic year and achieve the following cumulative GPA thresholds are eligible for (or may maintain) a merit scholarship:

- Scholarships are reviewed annually and will not be awarded to part-time students or those who completed fewer than 120 credits.
- No scholarship applies to referral or retake students.

10.2 50% Merit Scholarship (Highly Distinguished Students)

A 50% scholarship is awarded to highly distinguished students who maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 4.25, and who qualify under one of the following:

- Top 50 students in Thanawiya Amma nationwide.
- IB Diploma with score 36 or above (Business, Mass Communication, Engineering only).
- French Baccalaureate with score 18 or above (Business, Mass Communication, Engineering only).
- IGCSE with 100% score across 8 Ordinary Levels.
- Abitur with score 1 to 2.

This scholarship is deducted effective from the second semester of study.

10.3 Early Bird Scholarship

- Students who pay a non-refundable deposit of EGP 40,000 before 31 May 2026 are entitled to a 10% discount locked until graduation (2026-27 cohort only).
- The Early Bird scholarship is not included in the scholarship ceiling.
- All other scholarships/discounts are deducted from remaining fees after the category scheme is applied.

International Students: A discount of GBP 5,000 (or equivalent in other foreign currencies) is applied to all programmes and is locked until graduation. International students are NOT subject to Merit scholarship or School discount.

10.4 MOU Discounts

- All schools with a signed MOU with UH-GAF will grant their students an additional 10% discount (1st year only), applied in conjunction with the Early Bird discount.
- All B2B, with a signed MOU with UH-GAF will grant their students an additional 10% discount (1st year only), applied in conjunction with the Early Bird discount.
- GEMS and Gulf Schools: 10 % discount.
- The School discount has no registration deadline and is valid throughout the entire academic year in which the MOU was signed (covers both Semester A and Semester B).
- Students must submit an official school statement with stamp to be eligible.

10.5 Faculty & Staff Siblings Scholarship

10.6 Siblings Scholarship

- The second/third child enrolled simultaneously will receive a 10% scholarship.
- If one sibling withdraws, the scholarship for the second sibling is cancelled.
- Second/third siblings with a UH-GAF alumnus (UH graduate) in the family receive 10% throughout their studies.
- Sibling scholarship has no ceiling.

10.7 Orphan Scholarship

- Students who lose their father during their enrolment at UH-GAF receive a 20% scholarship in addition to their Academic Merit Scholarship.
- The orphan scholarship is applied with no ceiling for the remainder of the student's study period.

10.8 Martyrs' Offspring Scholarship

- A 50% scholarship for the full study period is granted to offspring of martyrs of the Ministry of Interior Affairs or Military Affairs.

10.9 Judiciary Members (Judges' Offspring)

- Judges' offspring are entitled to a 10% annual discount. An employment letter confirming the parent's active role must be submitted each academic year.

10.10 Sporting Excellence Scholarship

- International Tournaments (1st / 2nd / 3rd place): 50% scholarship; only an additional 10% Early Bird discount may be combined.
- National Tournaments: 1st place: 20%; 2nd place: 15%; 3rd place: 10%.
- Valid for the first year of study, or in exceptional cases until the next championship.
- Official documentation stamped by the Egyptian Olympic Committee or the Supreme Council for Youth and Sports is required.
- For returning eligible students, participation in the Egyptian Universities Championships under the name of UH-GAF “where applicable” is required in order to maintain eligibility for their scholarships in the following years.

10.11 Student-Gets-Student (SGS) Programme

- For every new enrolled and fee-paying student referred, the referring student receives a 5% discount on their tuition fees.
- Maximum cumulative SGS discount: 20%.
- The discount is applied in the second semester of the following academic year.
- Steps: (1) Complete the referral form first. (2) Referred student submits application. (3) Referring student receives a unique referral ID. (4) Once referred student pays, confirm via the confirmation link. (5) Discount is calculated and applied.

10.12 Ministry of Higher Education Leadership Discount

- A tuition fee discount of 20% is granted to the children of senior officials of the Ministry of Higher Education.
- The discount shall remain valid throughout the student's entire period of study, subject to continued eligibility.
- This benefit is awarded in recognition of the significant contributions of the Ministry's leadership in supporting and advancing the higher education sector.

10.13 Egyptian Actors Syndicate Discount

- A tuition fee discount of 15% is granted to the children of members of the Egyptian Actors Syndicate.
- The discount shall remain valid throughout the student's entire period of study, subject to continued eligibility and valid membership status.

10.14 Scholarship Ceiling Terms and Conditions:

1. Sports Scholarship (National Achievement): When combined with a Merit Scholarship, the total scholarship value must not exceed 25%.
2. Early Bird Discount: This is the only discount that is excluded from the scholarship and discount ceiling calculations.
3. School Discounts: Applicable for the first year of enrolment only.
4. Corporate Discounts: If combined with Judiciary Members and/or Actors Syndicate discounts, only the highest applicable discount shall be granted.
5. International Tournament Achievement (1st, 2nd, or 3rd Place): Eligible for a 50% scholarship. This scholarship may only be combined with an additional 10% Early Bird Discount. No other scholarships or discounts may be applied.
6. Martyrs Scholarship: A 50% scholarship that may not be combined with any other scholarship or discount.
7. Sibling Scholarships: Not subject to any discount or scholarship ceiling.

11. Direct Entry Scholarship – Conditions

- Starting from AY 2025-2026, IG students with 5 OL subjects and a percentage of 75% or above (medical sector / ECS) may qualify for Category C only.
- Starting from AY 2025-2026, IG students with 5 OL subjects and a percentage of 70% or above (all other majors including Pharmaceutical Science, Psychology, Nutrition) may qualify for Category C only.
- Merit scholarships (GPA Achievement) are fixed as specific EGP amounts (not a percentage of standard fees) from AY 2023-2024 onwards.
