WORKPLACE EXCELLENCE AWARDS 2023

Excellence in Employee Engagement & Team Building

This award is for a well-thought-out strategy linking employee engagement to the heart of the business, as well as organisations who have demonstrated the ability to create a positive and enjoyable environment for employees through social and team building events.

Entrants should provide details of the strategy itself and demonstrate how it measures improvements in engagement and detail the business outputs.

This category will be judged upon each applicant's (2000 word max) entry statement.

Please note that your document should be **no more than 2000 words in total**, which includes your **250 word summary**.

You may additionally include attachments (visuals, photos, charts, etc) that you think would help your application.

1. Summary	Outline in no more than 250 words why your organisation deserves to win this award
2. Overview	Detail how the strategy was developed and provide an outline of its objectives Demonstrate how the strategy links to your organisations objectives
3. Implementation & Communication	Provide an overview of how the strategy was implemented and communicated to the organisation
4. Challenges	Describe the challenges that were faced in introducing and implementing the strategy and how these were overcome
5. Outcomes & Results	Highlight the outcomes of your Employee Engagement & Team Building strategies and provide evidence of how you measure its success. Demonstrate how the strategies have benefited the organisation and its employees
6. Sustainable	Give examples of how employee engagement is being continuously monitored and improved

Essential tips for a successful entry

A successful application must try to address all of the points above. Marks will be allocated only on the evidence provided.

Use the headings shown to highlight your answers to those specific questions. Include information on your exceptional successes during the year such as systems, innovations or techniques that have reaped significant benefits.

Concentrate on facts that can be substantiated. Attachments can be included, which are particularly important for the judges to be able to see your successes or innovations.

Please remember that ONLY THE FIRST 2000 words of core information (and supporting material that you may have provided) of your submission will be assessed
