Description:

- Maintain accurate records of vehicle status, working hours, maintenance and hours of service
- Ensure proper securing methods
- Ensure the vehicle is clean, well maintained and safe
- Follow all traffic laws and safety regulations
- Other duties as required
- The role is seasonal and will experience gaps in work
- Falls under union scope, selected candidates will need to sign up and maintain membership with the union

Requirements:

- Minimum AZ Driver's License required with an acceptable drivers abstract
- Minimum 10 years' experience operating lowbed truck in offroad environments
- Physically fit with the ability to lift 50 pounds
- Experience with load securement
- Experience working in a busy environment with personnel and equipment
