A Heavy Equipment Operator operates heavy equipment, its attachments and ground engaging equipment in various types of projects across multiple industries such as road construction and maintenance, mining, quarrying, land clearing, forestry, logging as well as gas and oil. The heavy equipment operator inspects, maintains, transports, and operates this equipment and attachments.

The training program focuses on safety training, introduction to machine operation and maintenance, and includes the operation of three pieces of heavy equipment. (Loader, excavator, and dozer.)
