Paul had a strategy of multiplication:

Paul, the original teacher; **Timothy**, the student; **reliable people**, those trained by Timothy; and **others**, those taught by the third generation.

This is the model we follow in our training, and we see the impact it creates in communities throughout the world. The latest is the training in Ethiopia, where we are training members of three organisations as a follow-up to last year’s mentorship course, strengthening our impact in East Africa.

PRAISE POINTS

- Praise God for a very good three-hour consultation with a school for babies to Grade 1 on how to train staff online. This is hopefully the first step towards reaching more teachers and caregivers online.
- The Walking with Wounded Children course went very well, attended by a large group of young adults from De Doorns, as well as strong community and organisational leaders.
- “This course was not a typical children-in-crisis or trauma course — it was unique and one of the best courses I’ve ever attended. The way the theory was shared so clearly, and how we were taken step by step through the process and allowed to practise it, means that when we go home, we can use it straight away. I have never attended a course like this, and I really feel it equips one so well to be able to go out and practise this straight away in your own context.”
