Golden Hour Gala Raises \$426,500 — A Night to Celebrate and Remember

Saturday, October 4th, was one of those evenings that reminded us why we love this community so much. The Lake Chelan Community Center absolutely glowed — not just from the lights and décor, but from the energy and generosity of more than 125 people who joined us for The Golden Hour Gala, hosted by the Seven Acres Foundation.

Our board president, Brooke Isaak, opened the evening with heartfelt words of gratitude for everyone helping bring our vision of a vibrant community gathering place to life. From there, the night flowed beautifully. Shaimoom Newaz of Shai Creates guided the evening with warmth and humor, while David Marz, morning host on KOZI Radio, brought his trademark enthusiasm as auctioneer, keeping the room laughing, cheering, and bidding generously.

Guests enjoyed a buffet dinner prepared by Wapato Point Cellars and Winemaker's Grill, with live music from Moon Song Trio setting the perfect tone. Fundraising was as creative as it was fun — from a spirited Wine Pull and Dessert Dash to playful pledges tied to each Seattle Mariner run scored in that night's playoff game. Auction highlights included a Winterfest Weekend in Chelan, a luxury Mazatlán vacation, a private dinner for ten prepared by Chef Steve Simmons, and the stunning "Lady of the Lake" artwork by local artist Maya Cowan.

Two million dollar matching fund offered through December 31st!

A highlight of the evening came when Bill Tsoukalas from the Boys & Girls Club of Lake Chelan shared how the Community Center is already making a difference for local youth and families. His message reminded us why this project matters so deeply. By the end of the night, we had raised \$426,500 — and thanks to a Two-for-One Matching Fund from a generous local donor, that total will be doubled. The same donor has previously pledged \$4 million to complete the Center's gymnasium and performing arts center, marking an incredible milestone for our community.

Looking back, The Golden Hour Gala captured everything we hoped it would — joy, generosity, laughter, and a shared belief in what we can achieve together. It was, in every way, a celebration of this extraordinary valley and the people who make it shine.
