ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- The applicant must hold a Bachelor's degree in Nursing from a university recognized by the Ministry of Education.
- The applicant must have a cumulative GPA of "Very Good" or higher, and must submit an official academic transcript.
- The applicant must have successfully passed one of the standardized English language proficiency tests
- A valid professional license from the Saudi Commission for Health Specialties (SCFHS) is required.
- Three satisfactory academic and professional letters of recommendation must be submitted.
- A copy of the Curriculum Vitae (CV) must be provided.
- Applicants are required to pay a registration fee of (1,000) and a seat reservation fee of (4,000). Both fees are non-refundable and are not considered part of the tuition fees.
- The applicant must successfully pass a personal interview.
- The applicant must also pass a medical examination.
- Priority will be given to candidates with at least two years of experience in oncology and palliative care nursing.
