TSCA Declaration of Conformity 2026

This compliance declaration issued by Elma Electronic AG refers to the regulations of the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), which is equivalent to the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA). On 6 January 2021, the EPA established the final rules under the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) Section 6 (h). These rules include measures to reduce exposure to certain persistent, bioaccumulative and toxic substances (PBT chemicals), which have been legally binding since March 2021.

Elma Electronic AG is committed to the protection of health and the environment. In this regard, we strictly comply with the control and restriction of chemicals as required by applicable laws and authorities. To the best of our knowledge, none of the chemicals listed below are present in our products at this time.

Substances subject to TSCA Section 6 (h):

- Decabromdiphenylether (DecaBDE), CAS 1163-19-5
- Phenol, isopropyliert, Phosphat 3:1 (PIP 3:1), CAS 68937-41-7
- 2,4,6-Tris(1,1-dimethylethyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP), CAS 732-26-3
- Hexachlorbutadien (HCBd), CAS 87-68-3
- Pentachlorbenzothiol (PCTP), CAS 133-49-3

At present, we have no indications or findings that would, in the context of our due diligence and risk assessment, require specific analytical testing. Based on the information available to us, we assume that none of our supplied products contain any of the substances listed under the current Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) Section 6 (h).

However, trace amounts resulting from impurities in raw materials, which have not been disclosed to us by our suppliers, cannot be entirely excluded. This declaration applies exclusively to the products supplied by us. Any modifications to these products during subsequent processing are not covered by this statement.
