FR. JIHOON KIM, M.A. – **김 지훈 대건 안드레아 신부님**

Born in Seoul, Korea, Fr. Jihoon was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Los Angeles in 2021 and serves as Chaplain for St. Gabriel Korean Catholic Center in Rowland Heights. Fr. Jihoon received his M.A. in Theology from St. John's Seminary in Camarillo, writing his thesis on St. Andrew Kim and the Korean Martyrs, which he is currently turning into a book.

A Franciscan friar of the Korean Province, Fr. Francis Lee received his B.S. and M.S. from Seoul National University, his S.T.L. from Boston College, and his Ph.D. in Theology from the University of Notre Dame. After teaching for four years at the Pontifical University Antonianum in Rome, he now serves as Assistant Professor of Systematic and Comparative Theology in the Franciscan School of Theology at the University of San Diego.
