Spotlight Speaker: Jeanne Beker Canadian TV Personality & Fashion Editor

For almost five decades, Jeanne Beker has been at the forefront of arts and culture. She earned her position as one of Canada's most recognizable celebrities as a founding member of MuchMusic and the iconic host of Fashion Television.

In her inspirational talks, she shares how she cultivated the drive, resiliency, and tenacity needed to fuel her incredible career, as well as the courage to face life's challenges while empowering audiences to do the same. A breast cancer survivor, Beker's journey has provided her with a rich, eye-opening experience. Her candour in discussing the peaks and valleys of her journey has inspired people around the world.

Active with several charitable organizations, Beker has received honorary doctorates from St. Mary's University and OCAD University. She's also been named to the Order of Canada, inducted into the American Marketing Association's Hall of Legends, and honoured with a star on Canada's Walk of Fame.

About Oak Valley Health's Markham Stouffville Hospital

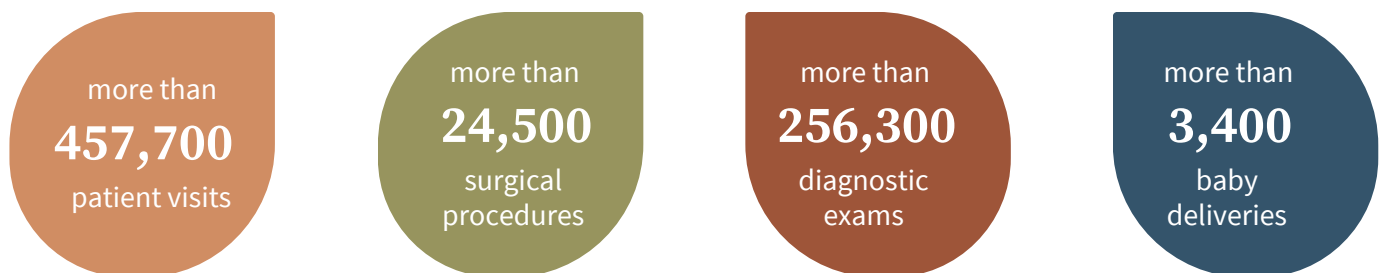
