TVM Sick Policy

If your child is not feeling well in the morning please keep them home to help stop the spread of illness.

Do not bring your child to school when ill. Illness includes any condition that prevents the child from participating comfortably in facility activities, illness that results in greater care than our staff can provide without compromising the health and safety of the other children, or if the child has any of the following conditions: temperature of 100 degrees or higher, unusual lethargy, diarrhea, vomiting, mouth sores, rash, pink eye, scabies, lice/nits or other infestation, impetigo, strep throat, chicken pox, pertussis, mumps, hepatitis A, measles, rubella, respiratory illness, shingles, etc.

Students experiencing vomiting and/or diarrhea need to remain home for at least 24 hours, symptom free, without the use of medication, before returning to school. Students who exhibit any of the following symptoms such as nasal drainage/congestion, new or worsening cough, shortness of breath, loss of taste/smell, rash, and/or fever will need a doctor's note, clearing them before returning to school.

If a student is out, three or more days, due to an illness, they need a doctor's note, clearing them to return to school. In the event your child gets sick at school, you will be called to pick up your child immediately. Your child must be picked up within 30 minutes of notification.

Head Lice

The school will call parents if lice are found on their child(ren). Parents are required to be at the school within 30 minutes of the phone call to prevent further spreading of this infestation. Lice are non-discriminatory and have no bias for gender, race, religion or socio-economic status. If we have multiple cases of lice, notices warning parents on the detection and treatment of lice will be sent home. Lice have a 14 day incubation period. Lice prevention is the responsibility of the parents. Students will not be able to return to school until all nits are removed from the child's head.
