

## Dress Code 2025-2026 School Year

Be A Good Human: Kindness Matters!

The TVM dress code policy is designed to provide students with a safe and professional learning environment. This is a policy in which personal style and preference in attire are respected as long as appearance does not interfere with effective teaching and student success. We expect students to give proper attention to personal grooming and to dress appropriately for the school activities in which they participate. It is recognized that the responsibility for compliance with the dress code rests with the parents and the student. Attire for extended field trips will be announced beforehand and students are expected to comply.

#### **Dress Code Guidelines**

- Students may not wear clothing or accessories that denote violent, crude, obscene or racist images. Clothing promoting drug use is also prohibited.
- For safety reasons, all students must wear closed toed shoes in order to participate in PE and or utilize the playground/field area.
- Shirts must cover the midriff at all times
- Shorts, skirts, and dresses must provide full coverage at all times.
- Uniforms must be worn on PE days, field trips, and for special events when indicated. No ripped or torn clothing on field trips.
  - PE: students must wear approved TVM bottoms and tops in order to receive full credit and can be purchased online from approved vendors.
  - Field Trips: students must wear a TVM polo with no ripped or torn clothing. If a trip includes swimming, a student is required to wear a TVM rashguard.
  - Swim Activities: A one piece swimsuit, sport-style two piece is permitted. String bikinis are not permitted.
    Swim shorts and rashguard permitted.

### **Enforcement**

Administration and enforcement of the dress code will be gender neutral and consistent. Teachers should focus on teaching without the additional burden of dress code enforcement. NO student should be subjected to embarrassment, unnecessary discipline or shaming as a result of dress code violations. The principal is the final arbiter of student dress and grooming.

Consequences for noncompliance are as follows:

1st infraction: Incident report, student will be asked to change

2nd infraction: Phone call home, student will remain in the office until a change of clothes can be brought from home.

3rd infraction: meeting between the student, parent and principal.



# **Uniform Requirements**

#### **TVM Polo Shirt**

All students, VPK-8th grade, will need at least one polo shirt with the TVM logo for field studies/guest speakers. Students will not be permitted to attend field studies without a TVM polo shirt.

### **TVM PE Uniform**

All students, VPK-8<sup>th</sup> grade, will need at least one PE uniform (top and bottom) with TVM logo which they are required to wear on their scheduled PE day. Student's PE days will be announced by their homeroom teacher when school starts.
