Low Sugar Policy

Treasure Village Montessori is a low sugar school. Food containing sugar as one of the first three ingredients is not permitted at school. Please be aware that sugar may be listed in several different forms. Fruit juices must be 100% juice with no sugar added. We do not permit sodas of any kind. If you are in doubt, check with us.

TVM Lunch Options

Students have the option of bringing a low-sugar, healthy lunch from home or ordering a school lunch. Lunch from school is available for a cost. If bringing lunch from home, we encourage the use of a labeled, standard size lunch box. School lunches are not an option in Field Study days. If lunch from home is required for field studies, lunch should be packed in a labeled disposable lunch bag, including bottled water.

- Lunches brought from home must be self-contained and ready to eat. We are not able to store lunches in climate control conditions or heat lunches up for consumption. Any uneaten food that has not been opened will be sent home to help parents determine the appropriate amounts of food needed at school for their children.
- For students ordering a school lunch, TVM works with Coral Shores High School to provide school lunches. The menu is determined by the district and subject to change, based on availability. Monthly menus can be found on the district's website .
- School lunch orders are placed by the student in their homeroom for the following day.
- If your student will be arriving at school late and will need a lunch for the next day, please contact Ms. Amanda, prior to 8:45am
- Please do not send:
 - Food which requires preparation at school (cup-o-noodles can be brought, premade in a thermos, fruit can be quartered at home and wrapped tightly in plastic wrap, etc.) The children do not have access to a microwave, so it will not be possible to send warm-ups to school.
 - All students are required to pack additional snacks and a refillable water bottle, regardless of bringing a lunch from home or ordering school lunch.

MEAL PRICE INCREASE ANNOUNCEMENT
