TTPNetwork was established as a not-for-profit charity in 1998 by a TTP patient who wanted other TTP patients to feel less isolated.

We provide information and peer support for patients with the rare blood disorder Thrombotic Thrombocytopenic Purpura. We also offer information and support for families of patients and medical professionals with an interest in TTP.

We support over 350 patients in the UK and more than double that engage with us from across the world on our social media platforms.

We focus on supporting patients and their families throughout the UK and Eire. We also provide information for patients, families and medical professionals through our dedicated website and social media presence which is accessible worldwide.

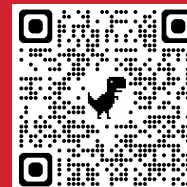
TTPBuddies

TTPNetwork was established to help patients and their families make contact with others who understood their experiences. That ethos has never changed, and we now host a TTPBuddy scheme to enable patients to access one to one peer support.

A TTPBuddy is simply someone who listens, cares, and understands. Not a medical professional, not a counsellor - just a real person with real experience of TTP, offering their time and kindness to someone who could use a friendly, familiar ear.

As a TTPBuddy you can expect to chat to another patient in a mutually agreeable way via text, email face to face or telephone.
