You may provide individual and group counseling services.

Functions & Responsibilities

- Assist individuals to work toward the maintenance and enhancement of their psychological, emotional, social, and interpersonal functioning.
- Help individuals struggling with addictions and mental health conditions such as anxiety, depression, OCD, posttraumatic stress disorder, neurodevelopmental disorders (ADHD), and traumatic brain injury.
- Works with the client as needed to obtain the desired social and emotional well-being and recovery through management of the issues that are caused by trauma.
- Work within a harm reduction model of care, conduct individual and group counseling sessions designed to increase client awareness of the patient population's related issues and enhance positive motivation for change.
- Collaborate with other team members, in the formulation of treatments.
- Provide appropriate treatment/support including individual and group therapy, couples and family therapy, and education.
- Performs other duties as needed.
