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AGED CARE

Aged Care is support provided to older people to continue to live independently at home or support provided when they are no longer able to live at home.

To be eligible for this program, people must be aged:

- 65 years or older (50 years or older for Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander people), or
- 50 years or older (45 years or older for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people), on a low income and homeless, or at risk of being homeless.

Types of aged care services that the Department of Health and Aged Care subsidise include:

- Home Care Commonwealth Home Support
 Program (CHSP) and Home Care Packages (HCP).
- Short-term Care After hospital or transition care for up to 12 weeks, restorative care for up to 8 weeks and respite care.
- Residential Care (Nursing homes)

Retirement Villages are also an option for older people however these are not subsidised by the government.

Note: Support at Home program will replace Home Care Packages and Short-Term Care from 1 July 2025.

WHAT IS CHSP?

The Commonwealth Home Support Programme (CHSP) provides entry-level support for older people who need some help to stay at home. The program aims to;

- help people live as independently as possible
- focus on working with them, rather than doing things for them
- give a small amount of help to a large number of people.

Types of supports include;

- social support 1:1 and group activities
- personal care
- domestic assistance
- food preparation
- · modifications to the home
- gardening and maintenance
- allied health (e.g. physio and therapy)
- shopping assistance
- transport
- · hoarding and squalor supports
- advisory services (e.g. dementia, vision)

An aged care assessment determines eligibility for the CHSP, including specific services. Most people in the CHSP only need 1 or 2 services to help them stay independent.

Meals on Wheels Southern Highlands provides nutritional freshly made meals, tailored to individual needs. Chef



The Head Chef oversees all of the kitchen processes to ensure fresh, nutritional food is provided to individuals who are unable to cook for themselves.

This position is paid at Hospitality Industry (General Award) Level 6 Cook (tradesperson) grade 5.

- Prepare and cook nutritious meals
- · Supervise food safety
- Supervise staff and volunteers
- · Other cleaning duties as required

The transport services are designed to help people to retain their independence, making it easier for people to socialise and stay connected with friends and family, attend medical appointments, shopping, errands and other social activities.



Staff are provided with orientation and training specific to their role e.g. manual handling, dementia awareness, cultural inclusivity training. Bi-lingual staff are welcome!

Applicants must provide a cover letter stating your employment history, training and/or education, languages spoken and availability. You will also need to provide your ID documents if selected to interview.



Professional Driver



Professional drivers transport older community members and people with disability to and from community outings and appointments.

Commitment: Casual or Full time.

Key Responsibilities:

- Drive vehicle (depots located in Minto and Mittagong)
- · Greet and farewell clients, respecting diversity
- Ensure the safety of clients is prioritised at all times
- Complete forms and/or documents as required

Requirements: LR licence, driving history check, national criminal history (police) check, working with children check, compassionate and patient demeanour, physically fit, flexible availability. Willingness to upgrade to Drivers Authority within 3 months.

Areas: Drivers are expected to drive in Camden, Campbelltown, Liverpool, Fairfield, Wollondilly and Wingecarribee.
