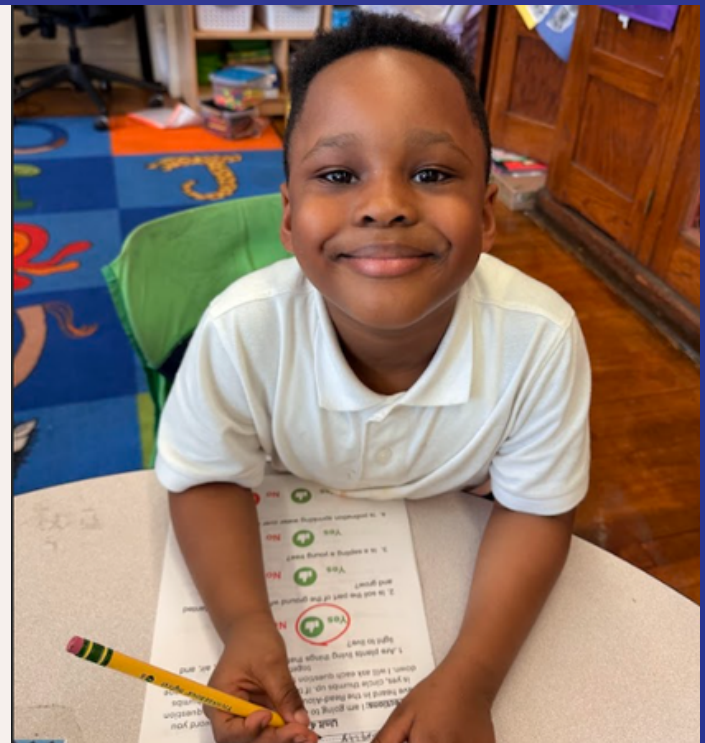

Dear TNAACS Families

TNAACS is a **pineapple-free school**. Students are **NOT** permitted to bring pineapples to school effective-immediately.

A member of our community has a **life threatening food allergy** to pineapples. The pineapple allergy is severe and exposure in any form (skin contact or ingestion) could result in anaphylaxis, a potentially fatal condition that requires immediate medical attention.
