Program Description: JCamp at JLA offers camper experiences with chosen specialty tracks within a general day camp setting for campers ages 5 - 12. - Communicate with parents about any CIT issues
- Support Counselors in planning and managing grade level appropriate activities
- Be responsible for the needs of the campers, your fellow staff members, and yourself
- Provide fellow staff members with your support
- Maintain strong lines of communication with all other staff members
- Behave appropriately and be an exemplary role model of Jewish living
- Be actively engaged with CITs and other Staff
- Be on time and participate in all assigned activities
- Dress appropriately for activities, always adhering to the Camp dress code.
- Additional responsibilities as required

Requirements

- Must have held a similar leadership position while working with children
- Desire and ability to work with children in camp setting
- Ability to relate to one's peer group
- Ability to accept supervision and guidance
- Desire to change behaviors as necessary to continue growth in position and role in Camp
- Be of good character, integrity, and adaptability
- Enthusiasm, sense of humor, patience, and self-control
- Well-developed sense of responsibility, good judgment, common sense
- Must understand the potential, characteristics, and issues of young children
- Must be sufficiently mature to guide impressionable campers through their time at Camp
- Must always respect the feelings of both children and their parents.
