
MOKUTI ETOSHA

Mokuti is the closest lodge to Etosha National Park, situated just outside the Von Lindequist Gate, near the historic Namutoni Fort. It offers guests a perfect blend of adventure, comfort and authentic Namibian hospitality, making it an ideal gateway to the wild. Upon arrival, a cool, green tropical oasis welcomes guests. Charming thatched buildings and two swimming pools, nestled amongst the vast indigenous gardens, give credence to the name "Mokuti", which in Oshiwambo means "in the bush".

A warm Namibian welcome awaits guests at this intimate lodge, with its extensive facilities including the Itulye Restaurant, SkyBoma, Enota Safari Bar, Oshana Pool Bar, Omulio Spa, two swimming pools, separate children's splash pool, two floodlit tennis courts, gym, the Ontoka Reptile Park, private airstrip and professionally guided game viewing safaris into Etosha National Park.

Mokuti boasts four waterholes on the property, which can be enjoyed during our sunrise and sundowner experiences or on a night drive.



ACCESS BY AIR

Windhoek via Fly Namibia ±90 minutes to Ondangwa Airport. Transfers can be arranged from Ondangwa Airport to Mokuti.

ICAO reference code: No. 3 with a non-instrument runway intended for daylight operation only. The airstrip has a gravel-surfaced runway of approximately 1 400m and a 600m concrete section, with a published LCN of 8. The designation of the runway is 08/26. Airstrip landing and parking fees are levied.

ACCESS BY ROAD

Mokuti is situated approximately 550km north of Windhoek, ± 5 hours travelling time. From Windhoek, follow the B1 in the direction of Okahandja for ± 505 km.

Turn left onto the C38 for 25km and follow the signs towards Namutoni Fort. Mokuti is on the left just prior to reaching the Von Lindequist Gate into Etosha National Park.
