

The PJ Project

The PJ Project has one simple aim, to help keep kids in need, warm in winter.

Over 208,000 kids are living in hardship. This means 1 in 4 children go without the basics, including food, shelter, healthcare and warmth.

Being cold has a real impact on children's health, school attendance and overall wellbeing. And as the cost of living remains high, winter places even more pressure on families already stretched thin.

The PJ Project is one small but practical way we can collectively make a difference, helping children stay warm through the colder months.

In 2025, we provided over 28,173 pairs of pyjamas to kids in 91 different cities and towns across 16 regions, and we know demand is expected to increase this year even more.
