

Subject Line: Reset Your DUPR Rating Risk-Free

Hi Players,

Important news: There is now a **risk-free** way to [reset your DUPR rating](#).

Ratings are built on historical match data. When a player improves quickly, it can take time for recent performance to fully reflect in their rating.

If you believe your level has improved and your current DUPR rating does not reflect that, the Reset Period gives you an opportunity to validate that using real competition!

## How the DUPR Reset Works

To qualify for a risk-free Reset, you simply need to:

- ✓ **Register** before or during the Reset window
- ✓ Play at **least 8 matches** with **2 different partners** (for doubles), or **8 matches** against **2 different opponents** (for singles).

That's it.

Your Reset rating is calculated **only** using matches played during the Reset window.

★ After the window closes, your final rating will be set to the **higher** of:

- your original DUPR rating, or
- the new Reset rating you earned


**All upside. Zero downside.**

## Good to Know

- Resets are optional and risk-free. Your rating can only stay the same or improve.
- Reset can apply to your doubles and/or singles rating
- There is **no maximum** number of matches or partners; play as much as you want
- If you don't meet the minimum requirements, your rating simply stays the same
- **All DUPR matches count**, including club play, leagues, events, and tournaments
- **Self-reported matches do not count**
- **Available worldwide**
