The Presidents' report is as follows –

Grievance Summary Under the Presidents' Report

- The University denied our Grievance filed for an employee that retired and was hired back into the University within 12 months. Discussion with E- Board.

- There was talk about Michigan Medicine taking over maintenance of Troy, Northville, and Brighton. Also Area 5 is getting an Industrial Electrician.
- Keep eyes open for non-union contractors.

- Follow-up meeting with Leti from HR and Lukeland about getting non-union companies out of the University. Pro decorating, Gemini Electric and I2G.

- Ty is also working with 252, ITS, and our inspectors to make sure these companies are doing the installations correctly, which is very sketchy work.

- September 26th is Union Day at Tiger Stadium. (\$4k budget) We purchased 2 buses that hold 112 people. We purchased a block of 112 tickets that are for sale, first come, first serve for members and their family \$30 per ticket.
- Negotiations will start in about a year, please help us with any ideas and verbiage to better our contract. In June, new contracts for our outside Unions take effect. I will be figuring out each trade's pay in respect to the outside. I am also working on a negotiation list.
