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### FINAL DISSEMINATION EVENTS IN DENMARK

In recent initiatives aimed at spreading the results of the Business 2030 project, People of 2050 organized two impactful dissemination events. These events, conducted in collaboration with prominent institutions, attracted a total of approximately 40 participants.

The first event, held in partnership with the Danish Technical University (DTU) and The Common Ones at the DTU SkyLab incubator in Copenhagen, set the stage for engaging dialogue among founders, coaches, and young entrepreneurs.

Members of People of 2050, Dorina and Luis, presented the project and shared the Business2030 project results with the participants. Attendees exhibited keen interest in Business2030 project, particularly in the Self-Assessment tool (SAT).





The second event was conducted in collaboration with Copenhagen Business School (CBS) at the Copenhagen School of Entrepreneurship (CSE) incubator. Members of People of 2050 invited more than 150 start ups present in that incubator as well as their founders. Alongside presenting the Business2030 project, the event encompassed discussions on circular economy principles and green business models, resonating strongly with the entrepreneurial community.

The attendees expressed keen interest collaborating with People of 2050. Noteworthy interactions with members the **CSE** sustainability panel illuminated avenues for integrating the project results into their professional endeavors, reflecting a mutual commitment to driving sustainability efforts forward.


