LAUNCH OF DIGITAL COURSE



The project partners have launched a virtual training course targeted at youth workers. The holistic training offers knowledge, skills and tools that guide and support young people in exploring green careers. The course includes 40 hours of learning with both individual and collaborative activities. The six modules are based on the principles of the green economy, including its positive impact on youth employment, core competencies in green jobs, strategies for engaging young people, and resources that support green entrepreneurship and job opportunities. The participating youth workers will undergo a final assessment and receive a certificate of participation after the course is completed, while the project partners will evaluate the course to identify strengths and weaknesses for future improvements.

The partners have developed a manual of good practices targeted at youth workers. This manual provides real-world examples and cases of successful green career paths and serves as a resource for young people, job seekers, educators and career counsellors. It presents a structured review of the green economy across different countries, and helping youth workers to identify best practices and gaps in existing approaches. The manual contains 30 exemplary practices, translated into the partners' respective languages.
