Bulgaria, set at the crossroads of Southeastern Europe, is a land of ancient forests, soaring mountains and wild, unspoilt valleys. Its capital, Sofia, lies beneath the dramatic slopes of Mount Vitosha, where alpine wilderness meets urban elegance.

The country is bordered by Romania to the north, Serbia and North Macedonia to the west, Greece and Turkey to the south, and the Black Sea to the east- a geographical position that has shaped both its rich culture and remarkable biodiversity.

Official Hunting Seasons

- Trophy hunting is available throughout the year, with the following regulated seasons:
- 1 September – 31 January
Red Deer, Fallow Deer, Wolf, Wild Turkey, Balkan Chamois
(Chamois: females 15 September – 31 October; males 1 December – 15 January)
- 15 April – 15 May
Capercaillie, Wolf, Balkan Chamois (males)
- 1 May – 30 October
Roe Deer
- All year round (individual hunts)
Wild Boar, Mouflon, Wolf, Fox, Golden Jackal, European Water Buffalo, Himalayan Tahr, Bezoar Hybrid Ibex, Kri-Kri Ibex
- 1 October – 15 January
Wild Boar (driven hunts)

Accommodation

- Bulgaria's hunting lodges reflect the extraordinary diversity of the land itself — from secluded alpine chalets hidden deep in pine forests to refined country estates overlooking golden valleys and distant mountain ridges. Each property combines comfort, character and the genuine warmth of traditional Bulgarian hospitality.

Please Read Carefully – Important Conditions

- I. Due to the complexity and international scope of our hunting programmes, full cooperation between the hunter and the professional guide is required and expected at all times.
- II. VIP trophy hunts and high-class specimens require an advance payment of 50% of both daily rates and trophy fees.
- III. The hunter selects the desired species and trophy classes, while Balkan Hunters Club designs the optimal hunting programme and selects the most suitable countries and territories accordingly.
- IV. All required documents — including passport copy and number, personal details, firearm make, calibre and serial number — must be submitted no later than three months prior to the start of the hunt.
- V. Any animal that is wounded and not recovered is considered taken and is subject to full payment, in accordance with international hunting ethics and regulations.
