1. Assumption of Risk

I understand that riding in a vehicle involves certain risks, including but not limited to accidents, injury, or property loss. I voluntarily accept these risks for myself or my child. **Seat belts are required at all times.**

2. Release & Hold Harmless

In consideration for being permitted to use the **OIC Transportation Service**, I release and agree to hold harmless **One In Christ Church, its officers, employees, agents, and volunteers** from all liability, claims, or demands for personal injury, death, or property damage that may arise during transportation, **except where prohibited by law.**

3. Scope & Duration

This waiver and consent apply to **all future transportation provided by OIC Transportation Service** for church-sponsored worship services, programs, and activities. It remains in effect **until revoked in writing** by the undersigned. Signing this form does not guarantee availability of transportation for any specific event or return trip.

4. Emergency & Medical Authorization

- **For Minors:** I am the parent or guardian and authorize church representatives to obtain emergency medical treatment if necessary. I accept responsibility for any resulting costs.
- **For Adults:** If I am incapacitated, I authorize reasonable emergency medical care until my emergency contact is reached.

5. Acknowledgement of Understanding

I have read and understood this document. I am voluntarily signing it and acknowledge that it constitutes a **legally binding release** of liability.

OIC Transportation Service: Policy & Guidelines

Purpose & Scope

The **OIC Transportation Service** helps individuals attend **church-sponsored worship services and activities**. It is a volunteer ministry of One In Christ Church, not a commercial transportation service.

Priority is given to college students, teenagers (with parent or guardian consent), seniors, and those with genuine transportation needs.

Scheduling & Return

Riders must be **ready at the designated pickup time and location**. Vehicles may depart if a rider is late. Please give advance notice for any change or cancellation.

Return rides are not guaranteed—OIC will assist when possible, but riders should plan for their own way home.

Safety & Conduct

For everyone's safety:

- **Seat belts must be worn** while the vehicle is in motion.
- Remain seated, store belongings securely, and avoid distracting the driver.
- Alcohol, tobacco, or illegal substances are **not permitted**.
- Riders are expected to show **respect and cooperation** toward drivers and passengers.
- Disruptive or unsafe behavior may result in suspension of ride privileges.
- Minors must have a signed waiver on file from a parent or guardian.

Drivers & Vehicles

- All drivers are approved **volunteers** of the OIC church.
- Vehicles must be insured, registered, and properly maintained.
- The service complies with all applicable state and local traffic laws.

Rights & Limitations

OIC Transportation Service may **deny, limit, or cancel** rides based on safety, capacity, weather, or other valid reasons. Policies may be updated as needed.

This ministry is provided as a **voluntary service of One In Christ Church**, not as a public or for-hire transportation entity.
