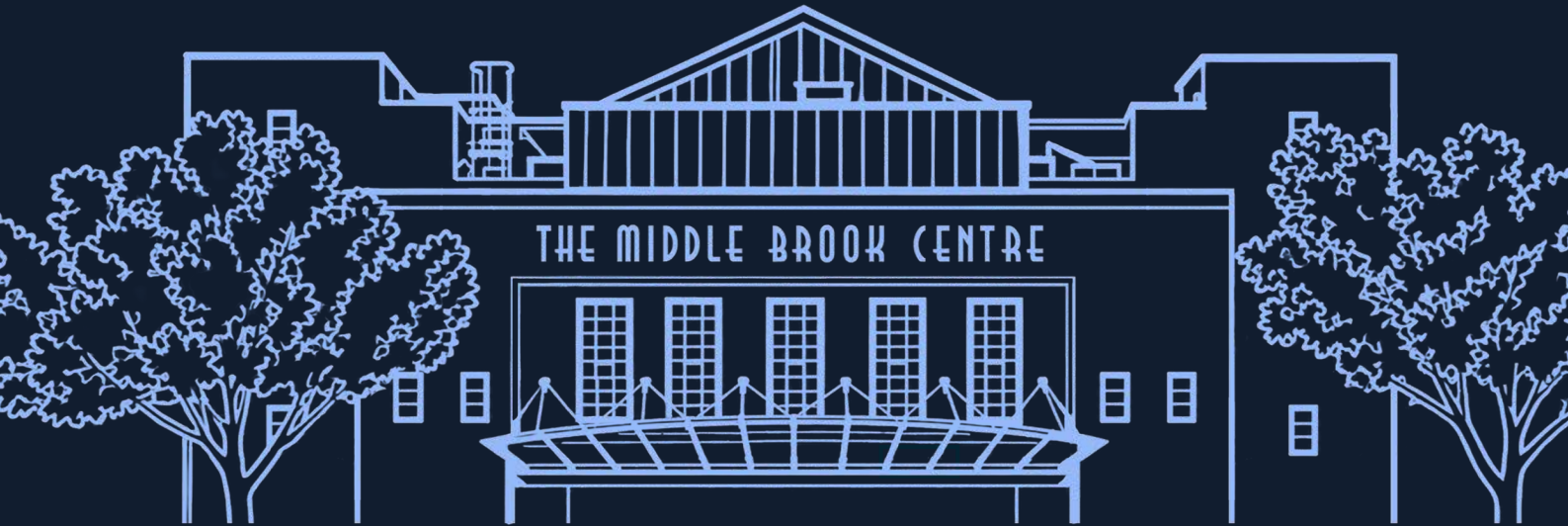


WELCOME TO HOPE CHURCH!

When & Where?

Our Sunday morning service starts at 10, with doors open from 9:30am for tea and coffee. We meet at **the Middle Brook Centre**, not far from the High Street in Winchester.

When You Arrive

There's a **welcome team** to greet you, help you find your way, and to answer any questions. When you arrive, grab a drink, take a seat on the ground floor or balcony, and settle in at your own pace.

Children & Young People

During most Sunday mornings we run **multiple groups for children** and young people from newborn right up to 18. Speak to our team who will point you in the right direction when you arrive.

After the Service

After the service, people stay for coffee and conversation. It's a great way to meet others. We also have a **Connect Point** where you can learn what's going on and how to connect into the life of Hope Church.

Join students from across the city who are doing life together and make Hope Church your home away from home.

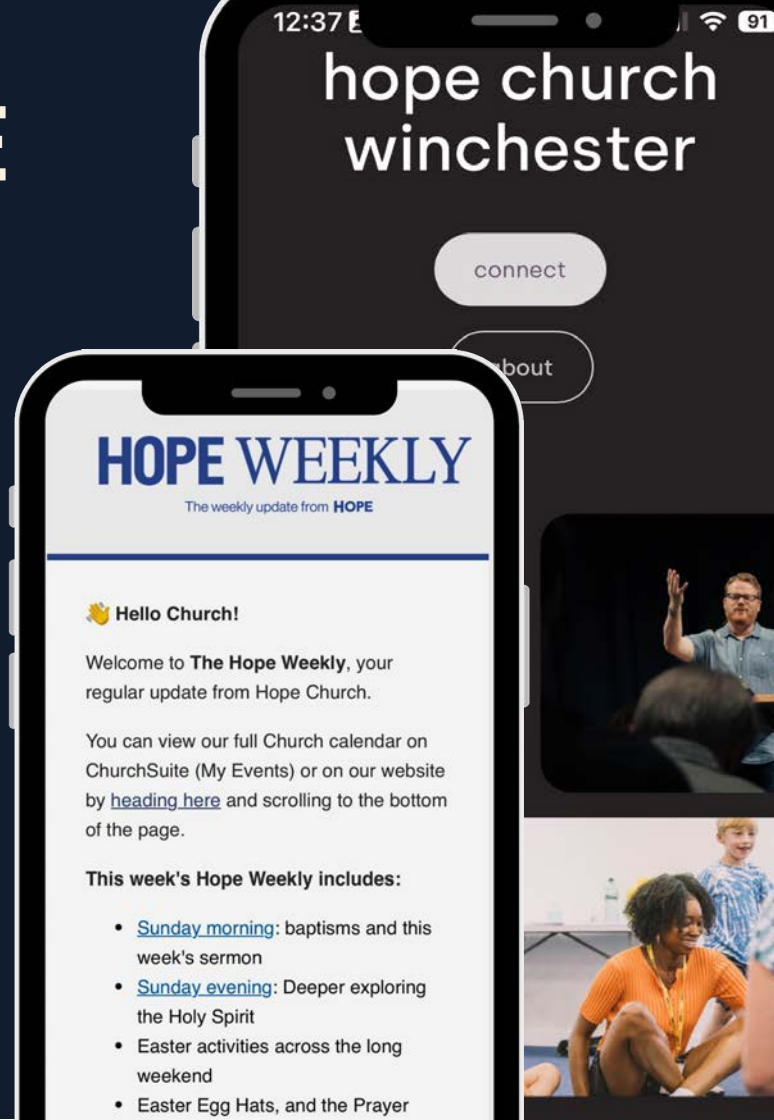

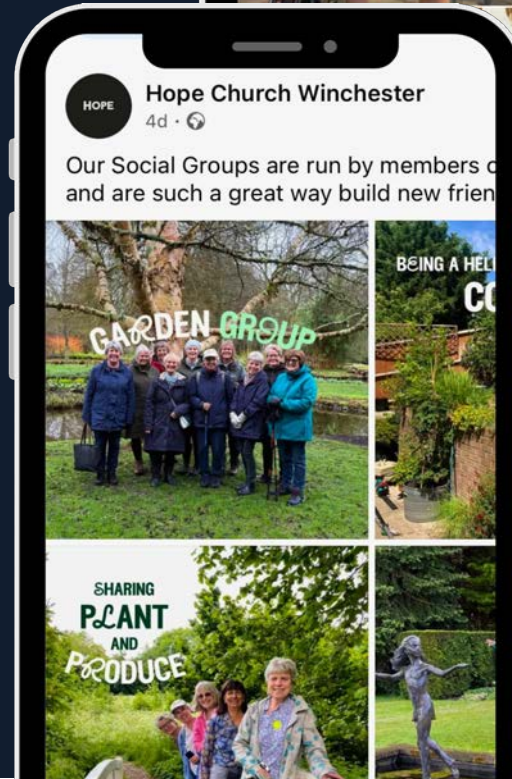
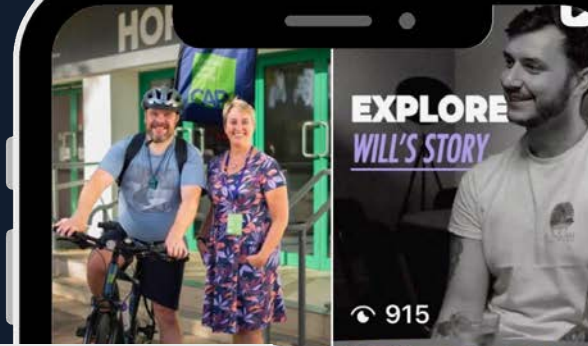
