This competition will be conducted under SNZ and Swimming Auckland Regulations with the following conditions:

Age: As at date of competition

Ages: 9/under,10,11,12, 13/14,15/16, 17/Over.

Entry Fee: \$14.00 per event.

Entries: To be entered directly into the SNZ Database

800m Freestyle: The 800m Freestyle will run at the end of session 1 and is open to any swimmer

aged 12/over who has achieved a level 2 time in 400m Freestyle. The number of entries will be limited to 24 based on rankings, with current 800m times taking

priority.

Closing date: Entries close at 10pm on Monday 3rd November 2025

Late entries \$20.00 only if there is spare lane and at the discretion of the

meet organiser.

Withdrawals: No refunds (unless accompanied by a medical certificate) will be given once

entries have closed.

Starts: Over the top starts may be used & the WA One start rule (SW 4.4) will apply.

Heats: Heats will be seeded slowest to fastest. Re-seeding or combining of heats will

be at the Referee's discretion

Marshalling: Swimmers should self-marshal at their lane 2-3 races before they are due to

swim. No races will be delayed if swimmers fail to appear for their race.

Programmes: Will be emailed to clubs prior to the day of the meet. Printed programmes may

not be available at the meet, except for officials, coaches and team managers.

Protests: Any protest must be accompanied by a fee of \$100 which is payable upon

the submission of a correctly completed protest form.

Pool Deck: All Team Managers and coaches should be on the SNZ Database and be police

vetted. They will also be required to sign in for each session.

Warm-up: It is a requirement of the meet that all swimmers are supervised during warm-

ups by their coach or manager - NOT their parent - to ensure the health and

safety of all competitors.

Additional lanes may be available for warm up and recovery during the session

in the dive well. All swimmers are expected to use these lanes in a safe and proper manner. Any swimmers abusing this privilege may be asked to leave by the duty staff.

Health & safety:

Coaches and/or team managers are responsible for their team members at all times and are expected to enforce any rules and regulations of the meet, the facility provider, ASA or SNZ.

Prior to entering swimmers, coaches must ensure participants have sufficient skill, experience and an understanding of safety to enter. Coaches should assess the health of their swimmers prior to, on the day of and during the event and withdraw swimmers who are injured or unwell.

All competitors must agree to comply with the SNZ Members Protection policy and the Sports Anti-Doping Regulations.

Officials:

All qualified officials should wear their ASA Officials shirt & be police vetted. Clubs are asked to supply 1 official per 4 swimmers/session, or more if possible.

PRIZES:

There are 2 separate categories for medals: **SPRINT and DISTANCE**. Points will be awarded for all events in each category: 4x50m in the SPRINT and 200/400 IM & 400 Fr in the Distance category.

Medals will be given to the top 3 male and female swimmers in each age group: 9/under, 10, 11, 12, 13/14, 15/16, 17/Over.

Swimmers MUST ENTER all events in their category to score points and be eligible for a prize.
