MEET CONDITIONS:

- SNZ Rules and local rules apply.
- Age as at first day of meet.
- Swimmers must have achieved a Level 1 or 2 qualifying time.
- All events will be graded scratch races.
- No time trials permitted.
- Over the top starts and the One Start Rule will apply.
- Late entries \$30.00 per event, only if there is a spare lane and at meet controller's discretion. Heats will not be reseeded.
- No refund on scratching unless a medical certificate is sighted no later than 48 hours from the end of the meet.
- Clubs to provide: 1 qualified official per 4 swimmers.
- This is a self-marshalling meet.
- Poolside Officials: We will endeavour to obtain the necessary number of officials but the number on poolside may be more or less than the requirement set out in SNZ Rules.
- All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Regulations.
- **12/U Tech Suit Restriction -**
 - This policy applies to all 12/U ASA swimmers and visitors competing at ALL ASA Meets except for ASA Age Groups and ASA Opens.
 - Swimmers who are unsure if their suit complies are encouraged to take it to the Technical Director for clearance BEFORE the start of the meet / session.
 - Team Managers/ coaches are encouraged to check that their swimmers' suits comply BEFORE the start of the meet/session.
- Only swimmers, officials, coaches, and authorised team managers to be on pool deck.
- Photography – Long lens cameras can be used with prior approval by organizers.

Health and safety is everyone's responsibility.

Coaches and/or team managers are responsible for their teams and are expected to enforce any rules and regulations of the meet, the facility provider, ASA and SNZ.

Prior to entering swimmers, coaches must ensure participants have sufficient skill, experience, and an understanding of safety to enter.

Coaches must assess the health of their swimmers prior to, on the day of and during the event and withdraw swimmers who are injured or unwell.

Teams must ensure minimum supervision of 2 adults (coach and team manager) per 12 swimmers entered.

No photography is permitted on pool deck during the swim meet unless prior permission has been obtained from the Roskill Swimming Club committee.
