Meet Conditions:

1. Age as at day of the meet, 15th August 2026.
2. The meet will be conducted under Swimming New Zealand and Swimming Auckland approved meet criteria. Waitakere Swimming will endeavour to obtain the required number of pool officials for meet approval but the number on poolside may be more or less than the requirement set out in SNZ Rules. .
3. Event Entry Fees: **\$15.00 PER INDIVIDUAL EVENT**. Late entries (**\$25.00 per individual event**) will be accepted at the discretion of the organiser, only if there is a spare lane. No refunds on scratching, unless a medical certificate is sighted no later than 48 hours from the end of the meet.
4. All events will be timed finals. Slowest to Fastest.
5. **This is a self-marshalling meet.** Over the top starts and the ONE START rule will apply. Re-seeding or combining of heats will be at the Referee's discretion.
6. **This is a paperless meet.** The meet programme will be available on the MeetMobile app. Hard copy programmes will be provided for all coaches, managers and Technical Officials
7. All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules.
8. **Clubs to supply: 1 Official per 4 swimmers per session** to a max of 6 unless requested for more before the meet. Clubs to email names of officials by Friday 7th August 2026 to swim@wsc.org.nz
9. Technical Director: Claudia Hill.

Health and safety is everyone's responsibility.

1. Prior to approving swimmers' entries, coaches must ensure participants have sufficient understanding, skill, and experience to conduct themselves in a manner that assures their safety and the safety of others.
2. All persons on pool deck (swimmers, coaches, managers, officials/volunteers) must enter through the back door.
3. No 'drop-off' at the back door please; foot traffic only. This area gets very congested around the start of warm-up. Please drop swimmers at the main car park and walk to the back door.
4. All swimmers must be able to demonstrate they have an entry in the competition.
5. Coaches must sign in and wear official identification at all times.
6. The Team Managers as designated by their club must enter through the competitors door and sign in to be on pool deck.
7. Officials and timekeepers must enter through the competitors door and sign in to be on pool deck.
8. All spectators must enter through the public entrance and be seated upstairs. No spectators are permitted on pool deck at any time.
9. No long lens photography unless approval has been expressly given by the Waitakere Swimming Club.
