Meet Conditions:

1. Age as at day of the meet, 17 October 2026.
2. Swimmers are required to meet the Swimming Auckland-Northland Level 1 or 2 qualifying standard and be 12 years old or under.
3. The meet organisers intend this to be an **Officiated Meet**, enabling qualification to national competitions. The meet will be conducted under Swimming NZ Approved Meet and Swimming Auckland-Northland local conditions. This includes the prohibition of "Tech swimsuits" for swimmers 12 years and under.

4. Event Entry Fees: **\$15.00 per individual event**. Late entries (**\$25.00 per individual event**) will be accepted at the discretion of the organiser, only if there is a spare lane. No refunds on scratching, unless a medical certificate is sighted no later than 48 hours from the end of the meet. No Entry Fees for relay events.
5. All events will be timed finals, with individuals' event results declared for males and females in the following age groups: 10 years and under, 11 years & 12 years.
6. This is a self-marshalling meet. Over the top starts and the ONE START rule will apply. Reseeding or combining of events and/or heats will be at the Referee's discretion.
7. Depending on session length, there may be (at the discretion of the Technical Director) a 30 minute break between events at approximately halfway through the provisional session timeline (once known).

8. This is a paperless meet. Session programmes will be emailed to clubs and posted on the Swimming Auckland-Northland website prior to the meet. Hard copy programmes will be provided for all coaches, managers and Technical Officials.
 9. All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules.
 10. Poolside Officials: The meet organisers intend this to be an **Officiated Meet**, with full Swimming NZ Meet Approval being the target. All clubs need to contribute to the required number of qualified Technical Officials. Clubs to supply: 1 Official per 4 swimmers per session to a max of 6 unless requested for more before the meet. Clubs to email names of officials by **midnight Wednesday 14 October 2026** to Barry Ashcroft (mteregistrar@outlook.com).

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SPECTATORS: All spectators must enter through the West Wave main entrance and be seated upstairs. No spectators are permitted on pool deck at any time. Mt Eden Swimming Club will not be charging an entry fee for spectators, but all spectators will be required to pay West Wave (at the main entrance) their standard spectator entry fee. This valid for the whole day; get your hand stamped to allow you to come and go between sessions.

Health and safety is everyone's responsibility.

1. If anyone (swimmers, coaches, managers and parents and other spectators) is feeling unwell, please stay at home.
2. Prior to approving swimmers' entries, coaches must ensure participants have sufficient understanding, skill, and experience to conduct themselves in a manner that assures their safety and the safety of others.
3. All persons on pool deck (swimmers, coaches, managers, officials/volunteers) must enter through the back door.
4. No 'drop-off' at the back door please; foot traffic only. This area gets very congested around the start of warm-up. Please drop swimmers at the main car park and walk to the back door.
5. All swimmers must be able to demonstrate they have an entry in the competition.
6. Coaches must sign in and wear an NZSCAT identification at all times.
7. Team Managers must sign in and will be issued with an identification card.
8. Officials and timekeepers must sign in and either be wearing an ASA Technical Officials shirt or be issued with an identification card.
9. All spectators must enter through the West Wave main entrance and be seated upstairs. No spectators are permitted on pool deck at any time.
10. No long lens photography unless approval has been expressly given by the Mt Eden Swimming Club.
