

What is Family Film Night?

Family Film Night began as a simple yet powerful way for families to spend time together, watching great films and having meaningful conversations. Originally designed to be used in the home, this resource is suitable for all families—whether they are part of a church community or have no faith background at all.

It offers different levels of engagement to meet families where they are. At its most accessible, families can simply enjoy the film and reflect on it through fun activities and open-ended “wondering questions.” For those who wish to explore their faith more deeply, an optional “Going Deeper” section connects the themes of the film to passages from the Bible, offering opportunities for spiritual growth and conversation.



How does it work?

Family Film Night is designed to create meaningful, shared moments - all from the comfort of home.

Begin by **setting the scene** with your favourite snacks and cozy surroundings. After watching the film, families can explore:

🎨 **3 Themed Activities** – Simple, creative ideas linked to the film's message

💡 **3 Wondering Questions** – Open-ended prompts to spark conversation

✝ **3 Going Deeper Questions** – For those who want to explore a faith connection

🌟 **1 Big Question** – A key theme everyone can engage with, no matter their background
