

Going Deeper

Read John chapter 14, verses 2-3. Jesus said God's house has many rooms and there is a place for all of us. Compare the witch's old broom to the new broom, consider how she made space for each new friend. What would your room in God's house look like?



The witch welcomed everyone on the broom and by the end, they had become a family. In Galatians chapter 3, verses 26-29, we see that as believers we have become children of God, a family. Who are the people in your Christian family (church/believers in Christ) and what difference have they made in your life and faith?



The witch possibly felt alone when she was being chased by the dragon, but her new family were there for her and prepared to fight for her. In Ecclesiastes chapter 4, verses 9-12 we read how having a friend can make things in life easier and give us strength. Is there anything that you're struggling with and felling alone? Who can you go to for help? Is there someone you know who is struggling or feeling alone? How can you help them?

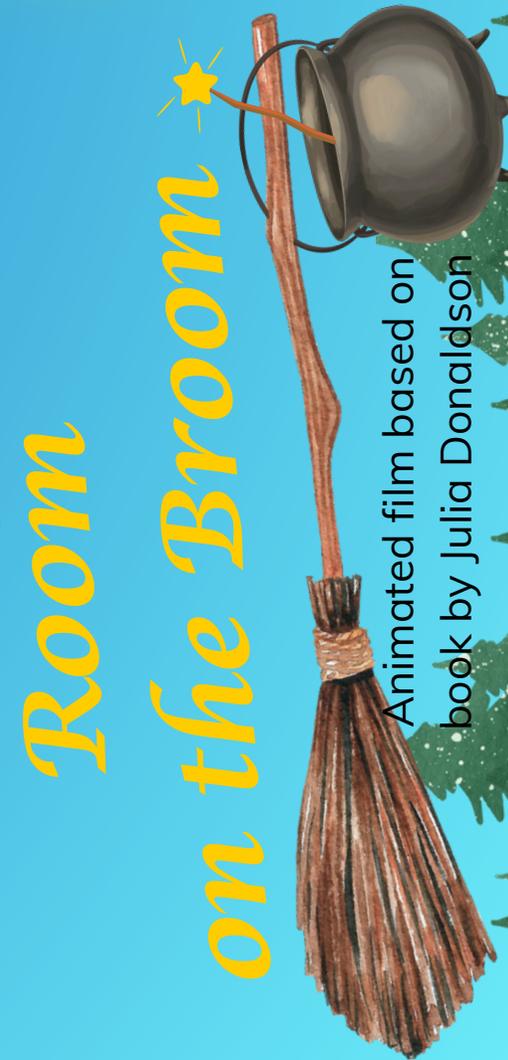
What does it mean to make room for everyone?

Activities

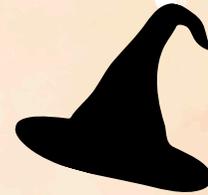
Challenges

Hats

Have a go at making a really tall hat! You can use things such as the cardboard from kitchen rolls, cushions, material etc. How tall can you make it before it falls off your head?



Witches Brew Soup

Get creative and a little bit brave, have a go at making a witches brew. Make some rules before hand (e.g. a savoury soup; a cold soup; perhaps a sweet soup!). Get each member of the family to choose an ingredient (it can be anything as long as it's edible) and place it on the counter. Choose up to 20 items and now choose what you will put in your soup! No recipes, just total guess work.

Alternatively, you can do a fondue and choose random (edible) items to dip in it.
