
MEETING OVERVIEW

The City of Milwaukee is hosting an open-house style public involvement meeting to present information and the preferred design alternative for the N. Sherman Boulevard project from W. North Avenue to W. Capitol Drive. Intersections at W. Hope Avenue and W. Congress Street are also being improved as part of this project.

MEETING PURPOSE

- Learn about future construction staging plans
- Explore the impacts to the North Sherman Boulevard Historic District
- Discuss the proposed alternative with the project team

Project Limits and Intersection Improvements



PROJECT GOALS

The pavement on N. Sherman Boulevard is reaching the end of its service life and needs to be replaced. The following improvements are also proposed as part of this project:

- Enhance safety for people walking and biking by replacing sidewalks, improving crosswalks and curb ramps and reallocating space to incorporate dedicated bicycle lanes
- Replace storm sewer laterals
- Install new street lighting
- Replace existing traffic signals with modern safety technology

This project is within the North Sherman Boulevard Historic District, and the project team recognizes the significance of this area. A key factor during the design process is preserving the historic atmosphere of the corridor.



UTILITY COORDINATION

Before construction, utility companies will be on site upgrading and relocating underground infrastructure. Road construction provides an opportunity for utility companies to upgrade their equipment in coordination with the project team to limit disruptions to the neighborhood. This work is primarily done before construction begins, and residents and businesses should anticipate seeing utility crews on site as early as 2027.
