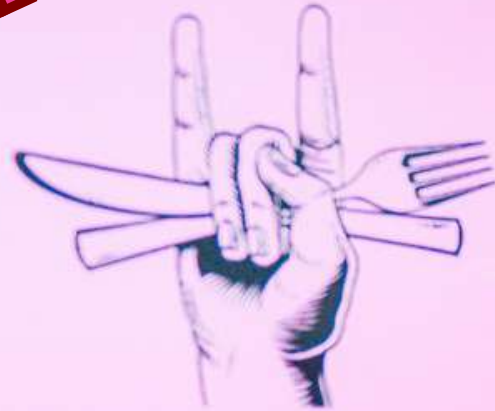


ANTI-BANQUET IMPACT REPORT 2025

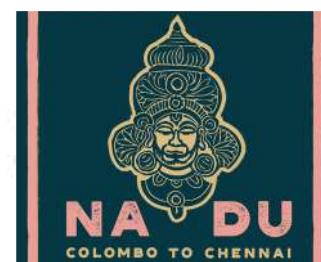

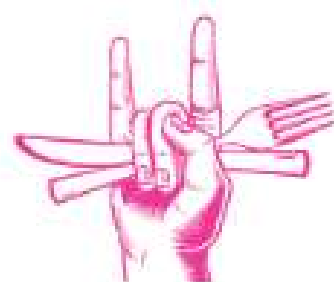

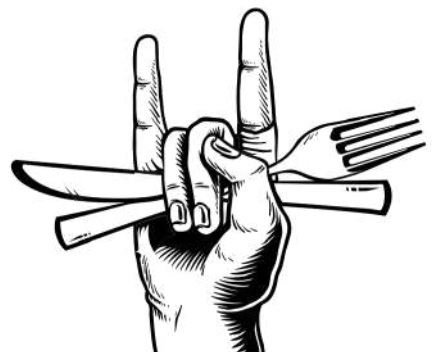

This is what YTL Arena is all about: building relationships, breaking barriers, and shaping the future of live music for the surrounding community, with a little of fun thrown into the mix too!

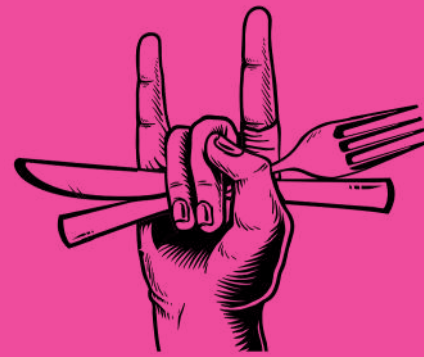

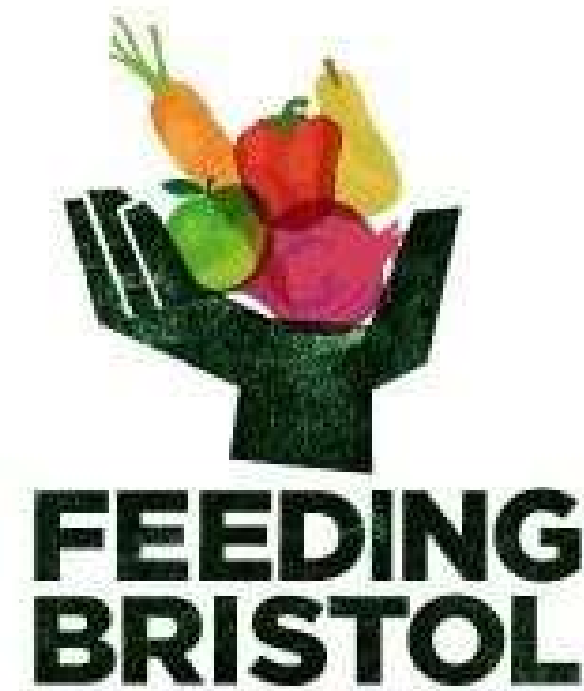
Last Thursday, Anna Wilson and Tom Powles swapped the court for the kitchen at the @anti_banquet. 🍴

BRISTOL LOCAL FOOD FUND

BLFF IS A VOLUNTARY PROJECT WITH A VISION TO CREATE A CITY OF FOOD JUSTICE, WHERE EVERYONE CAN ACCESS NUTRITIOUS, AFFORDABLE AND CULTURALLY APPROPRIATE FOOD, WORKING IN PARTNERSHIP WITH QUARTET COMMUNITY FOUNDATION AND FEEDING BRISTOL.

£50,000 OF THE MONIES RAISED WERE DONATED TO BLFF WHO WERE RESPONSIBLE FOR DISTRIBUTING THIS AMONG THE COMMUNITY FOOD PROJECTS TACKLING INSECURITY WITHIN BRISTOL. BLFF COMBINED THE FUNDS WITH £20,000 THEY HAD RAISED TO BE ABLE TO DISTRIBUTE £70,000. USING A PANEL OF CAREFULLY RECRUITED PEOPLE WITH LIVED EXPERIENCE OF FOOD INSECURITY AND A SPECIAL GRANT AWARDS PROCESS TO ENSURE THAT IT WAS EQUITABLE, TARGETING COMMUNITIES AND AREAS MOST IN NEED, AND PRIORITISING FOOD INSECURITY FOR THE MOST VULNERABLE.

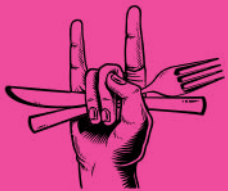

“WE BELIEVE IN A CITY WHERE EVERY PERSON FEELS THEY BELONG. CELEBRATING THE 91+ LANGUAGES HERE IN BRISTOL, WE USE THE TRANSFORMATIVE POWER OF FOOD TO BUILD STRONGER, HEALTHIER, MORE CONNECTED COMMUNITIES.”

THE £30,000 DONATED TO 91 WAYS PLAYED A VITAL ROLE IN STRENGTHENING THEIR MISSION TO BUILD CONNECTION, BELONGING, AND WELLBEING ACROSS BRISTOL'S DIVERSE COMMUNITIES. THIS SUPPORT ENABLED THEM TO EXPAND ON FOOD-FOCUSED PROGRAMMES, REDUCE ISOLATION, AND FOSTER MEANINGFUL INTERCULTURAL UNDERSTANDING ACROSS THE CITY.

AT THE HEART OF 91 WAYS IS THE BELIEF THAT SHARING FOOD OPENS THE DOOR TO CONVERSATION, CONNECTION, AND COMMON GROUND. BY BRINGING DIVERSE GROUPS TOGETHER AROUND THE TABLE, THE ORGANISATION CREATES WELCOMING SPACES WHERE GENUINE RELATIONSHIPS CAN FORM AND WHERE BRISTOL'S RICH CULTURAL HERITAGE CAN BE CELEBRATED. THROUGH EDUCATION AND PRACTICAL, HANDS-ON COOKERY COOKING CLASSES WHERE PARTICIPANTS DEVELOP ESSENTIAL SKILLS, FROM PREPARING NUTRITIOUS, LOW-COST MEALS TO IMPROVING CHOPPING AND KITCHEN CONFIDENCE, PARTICIPANTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO CREATE NOURISHING MEALS ON A BUDGET, IMPROVING BOTH THEIR HEALTH AND LONG-TERM RESILIENCE. 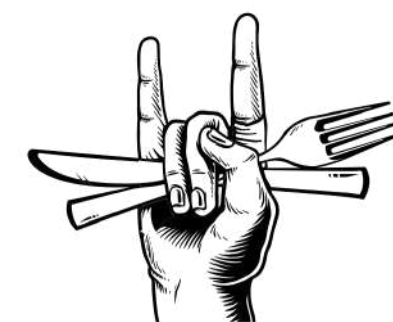

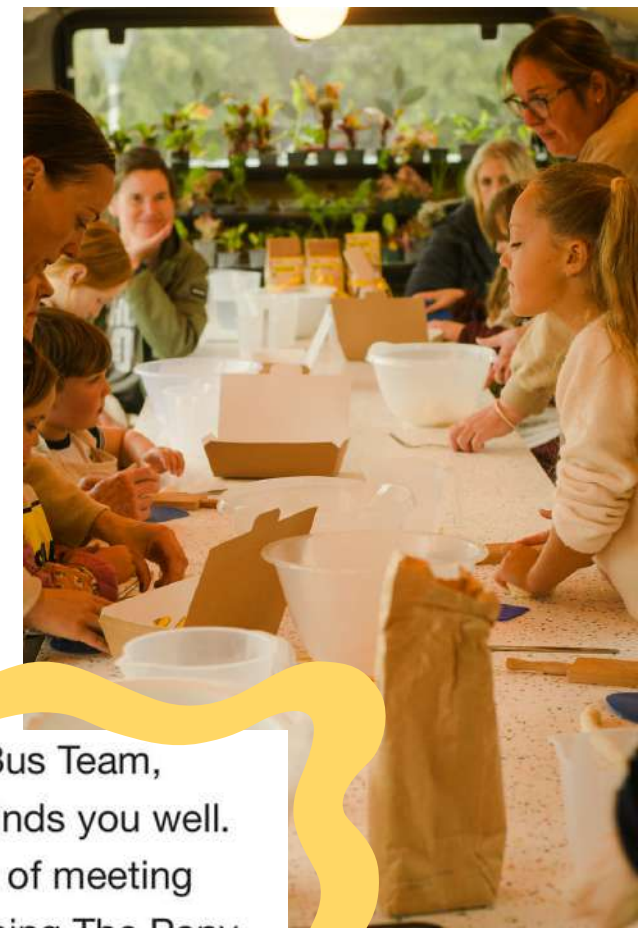

THE PONY FARM BUS



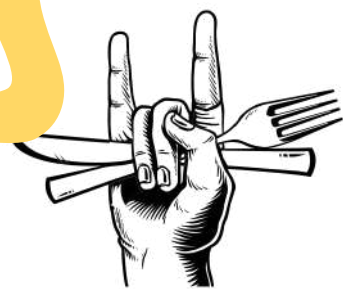
THE £17,000 DONATED TOWARDS THE PONY FARM BUS HAVE HELPED WITH THE RENOVATION COSTS OF THE DOUBLE DECKER BUS. DONATED BY FIRST BUS AND NAMED 'JAMES' THE BUS NOW FEATURES A COLORFUL KITCHEN, HERB GARDEN, DINING TABLE AND LIVE GROWING SYSTEM. ALMOST COMPLETE, A SCHEDULE OF EVENTS AND SCHOOL VISITS ARE BEING BOOKED IN AND WE ARE LOOKING FORWARD TO GETTING OUT INTO THE COMMUNITY AND DELIVERING THE PROGRAMS TAILORED TO GROUPS NEEDS, AGE, LOCATION AND SEASON. THE AIM IS 25 SCHOOLS AND COMMUNITY GROUPS A YEAR, OFFERING ENGAGING, INTERACTIVE AND FUN WORKSHOPS, DEMONSTRATIONS AND CLASSES AS WELL AS SERVICING COMMUNITY AND YOUTH GROUPS.

THE COLORFUL AND FUN SETTING WILL INSPIRE AND AID LEARNING, SHARING KNOWLEDGE OF WHERE FOOD COMES FROM AND HELPING CHILDREN MAKE HEALTHIER CHOICES, WE BELIEVE THAT LEARNING ABOUT FOOD SHOULD BE ENJOYABLE AND ACCESSIBLE TO EVERYONE.

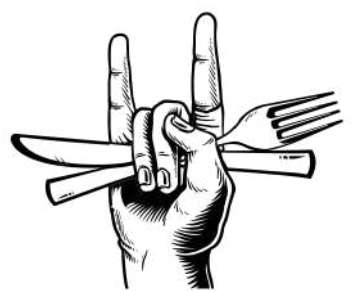

EVERYTHING WE DO WITH THE PONY CIC IS ABOUT INSIGHTING A POSITIVE FOOD CULTURE AND EDUCATING OURSELVES AND OTHERS THROUGH THE FUTURE OF FOOD. AT FODA 2025 WE WERE PROUD TO OFFER FREE PASTA ROLLING AND PIZZA MAKING WORKSHOPS FOR CHILDREN, AS WELL AS CRAFTING THEIR OWN COOKBOOKS AND ‘GYOTKU’ CREATING PRINTS USING INK AND FISH SKINS. £10,000 OF THE MONEY RAISED BY THE ANTIBANQUET WAS USED TO FUND THIS PROJECT AND ENABLED US TO OFFER THESE FREE ACCESSABLE AND EDUCATIONAL WORKSHOPS TO CHILDREN AND FAMILIES.

WITH FODA OUR MISSION IS TO CREATE A PLATFORM FOR FOOD INNOVATION AND THE FUTURE OF FOOD PRODUCTION, BRINGING TOGETHER LEADING INDUSTRY EXPERTS, LEADERS AND THINKERS THROUGH A PROGRAMME OF EDUCATIONAL SYMPOSIUM TALKS, EXHIBITIONS AND PRACTICAL WORKSHOPS.

CAUSES SUPPORTING ON THE NIGHT



GENERATION SOIL CIC IS A BRISTOL-BASED SOCIAL ENTERPRISE TRANSFORMING LOCAL FOOD WASTE INTO LIVING COMPOST THAT NOURISHES PEOPLE, PLANTS, AND THE PLANET. THEIR MISSION IS SIMPLE: CLOSE THE LOOP BETWEEN WHAT WE EAT AND WHAT WE GROW. BY KEEPING FOOD WASTE LOCAL, WE CUT CARBON EMISSIONS, REGENERATE BRISTOL'S URBAN SOILS, AND RECONNECT PEOPLE TO THE NATURAL CYCLES THAT SUSTAIN LIFE.

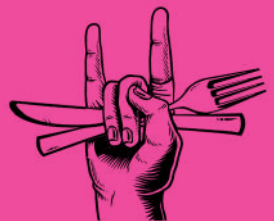
THE GUYS GOT STUCK IN AND WERE ON HAND ALL DAY AND EVENING TO TAKE THE FOOD WASTE AWAY FROM THE KITCHENS BY THE BUCKET LOAD!

‘WE COLLECTED 16X 20 LITRE BUCKETS WHICH WE TREATED WITH BOKASHI (TO FERMENT THE FOOD WASTE) BEFORE PROCESSING LITERALLY TWO MINUTES ROUND THE CORNER FROM ASHTON GATE STADIUM AT OUR COMPOST HUB. IT WILL BE REDISTRIBUTED AROUND BRISTOL WHERE NEEDED, INCLUDING OUR NEW TWO ACRE FOOD FOREST MARKET GARDEN!’



SOCIAL IMPACT BUSINESS, KABISA'S PROFITS CONTRIBUTE TO IMPROVING FOOD AND WATER SECURITY FOR SMALL-SCALE SUBSISTENCE FARMING COMMUNITIES IN SOUTHEASTERN KENYA BY ALLEVIATING ECONOMIC PRESSURES FACED BY THE ENVIRONMENTAL CONSEQUENCES OF CLIMATE CHANGE.

KABISA WAS INITIALLY CONCEPTUALISED TO CREATE A BRIDGE FOR EAST AFRICAN ARTISTS TO SELL THEIR CRAFTS TO A WIDER MARKET. IN ADDITION, IT HAS ORGANICALLY DEVELOPED INTO GENERATING SELF-EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES FOR YOUNG WOMEN FROM RURAL KENYA, TANZANIA AND ZANZIBAR.

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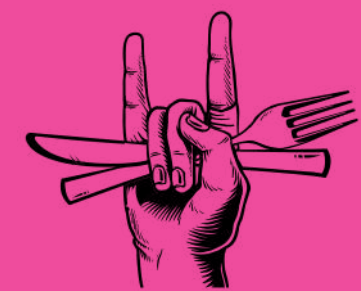
