



# Kindergarten Supply List

- 2 Pencil Boxes (plastic type that snaps and will fit in their desk easily) (L)
  - 24 pencils, No. 2, wooden. \* (kept in their book box and used as needed)
  - Travel tooth brush holder tube\* for sharpened pencils in their desk
  - Two 16-count boxes of crayons (the second box is for when they run out)
  - Scissors (all metal blades, no plastic please)
  - Book Bag (L)
  - 4 regular-sized cans of Play-Doh (L), two for the classroom
  - 2 pocket folders\* (L) Vinyl plastic folders
  - 8 pack of washable markers (classic colors) \* (individually labeled)
  - 8 glue sticks\* (individually labeled) Four for the classroom
  - 1 bottle of Elmer's glue\* (L)
  - One watercolor paint set with a paint brush included\* (L)\*
  - One four-pack of dry-erase markers\* (L)
  - A coloring/activity book\* (L)
  - 2 packs of baby wipes (face washing after lunch)
  - Oversized old shirt for art
  - Primary Composition Notebook 100 pages (found at Walmart, pages are half blank for illustrations and half lined for writing)
