Therefore, leaving the discussion of the elementary principles of Christ, let us go on to perfection, not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God, of the **doctrine of baptisms**, of laying on of hands, of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment. And this we will do if God permits.

God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit **and** with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.

Acts 8:6,12

And the multitudes with one accord heeded the things spoken by Philip, hearing and seeing the miracles which he did...**when they believed** Philip as he preached the things concerning the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, both men and women were baptized.

Acts 8:14-16

Now when the apostles who were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent Peter and John to them, who, when they had come down, prayed for them that they might receive the Holy Spirit. For as yet **He had fallen upon none of them**. They had only been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.

Acts 8:17

Then they laid hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit.

15

Acts 8:18-23

And when Simon saw that through the laying on of the apostles' hands the Holy Spirit was given, he offered them money, saying, "Give me this power also, that anyone on whom I lay hands may receive the Holy Spirit." But Peter said to him, "Your money perish with you, because you thought that the gift of God could be purchased with money!...your heart is not right in the sight of God. Repent...you are poisoned by bitterness and bound by iniquity."

Acts 9:4-5

Then he fell to the ground, and heard a voice saying to him, "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me?" And he said, "Who are You, Lord?" Then the Lord said, "I AM Jesus, whom you are persecuting.

17

Acts 9:6

So he, trembling and astonished, said, "Lord, what do You want me to do?"

18

Acts 9:17

Ananias went his way and entered the house; and laying his hands on him he said, “Brother Saul...

19

Acts 9:17

...the Lord Jesus, who appeared to you on the road as you came, has sent me that you may receive your sight **and be filled with the Holy Spirit.**”

Acts 10:28

Then he said to them, “You know how unlawful it is for a Jewish man to keep company with or go to one of another nation. But God has shown me that I should not call any man common or unclean.

Acts 10:34-35

Then Peter opened his mouth and said: “In truth I perceive that God shows no partiality. But in every nation whoever fears Him and works righteousness is accepted by Him.

22

Acts 10:43-45

...whoever believes in Him will receive remission of sins.” While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who heard the word. And those of the circumcision who believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out on the Gentiles also.

Acts 10:46

For they heard them speak with tongues and magnify God.

24

Acts 19:1-2

...finding some disciples he said to them, “Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?”

25

Acts 19:2-5

So they said to him, “We have not so much as heard whether there is a Holy Spirit.” And he said to them, “Into what then were you baptized?” So they said, “Into John’s baptism.” Then Paul said, “John indeed baptized with a baptism of repentance, saying to the people that they should...

Acts 19:2-5

...believe on Him who would come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus.” When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.

Acts 19:6-7

...And when Paul had laid hands on them, the Holy Spirit came upon them, and they spoke with tongues and prophesied. Now the men were about twelve in all.
