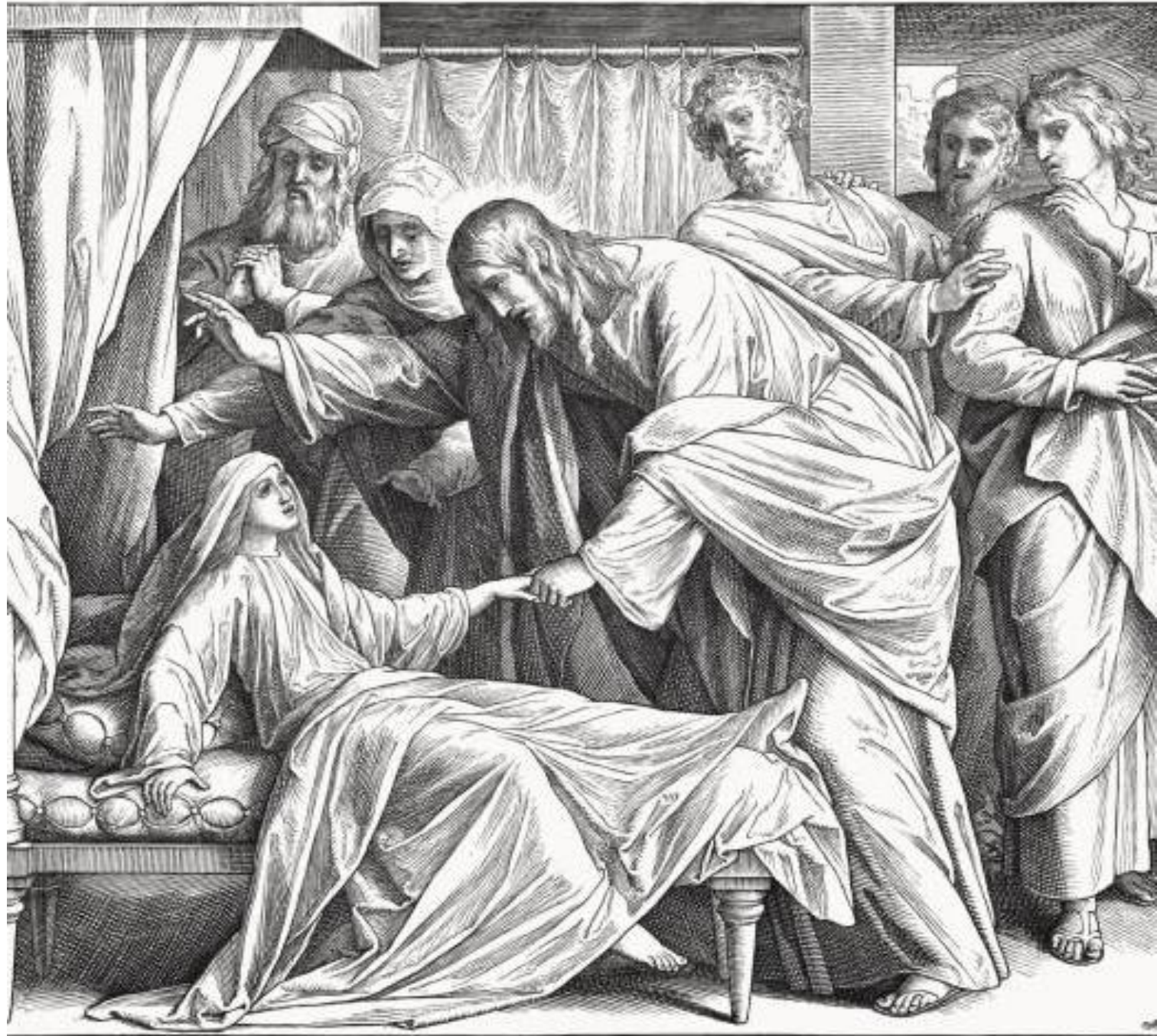

How Jesus Healed in the Gospels

Jesus heals a blind
man in two stages

MK 8



IS 35:4-6

“Be strong, do not fear! Behold, your God will come with vengeance, With the recompense of God; He will come and save you.” Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, And the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped. Then the lame shall leap like a deer, And the tongue of the dumb sing.

MK 8:14-21

Now the disciples had forgotten to take bread, and they did not have more than one loaf with them in the boat.

MK 8:14-21

Then He charged them, saying,
“Take heed, beware of the leaven
of the Pharisees and the leaven
of Herod.”

LK 12:1

...He began to say to His
disciples first of all, “Beware of
the leaven of the Pharisees,
which is hypocrisy.

LK 23:8

Now when Herod saw Jesus, he was exceedingly glad; for he had desired for a long time to see Him, because he had heard many things about Him, and he hoped to see some miracle done by Him.

MK 6:17-18

For Herod himself had given orders to have John arrested, and he had him bound and put in prison. He did this because of Herodias, his brother Philip's wife, whom he had married. For John had been saying to Herod, "It is not lawful for you to have your brother's wife."

MK 8:14-21

And they reasoned among themselves, saying, “It is because we have no bread.”

1 Cor 2:14

the natural man does not receive

And though a tenth [of the people] remain

[eaten up and burned] like a terebinth tree
or like an oak whose stump and substance
remain when they are felled or have cast
their leaves. The holy seed [the elect
remnant] is the stump and substance [of
Israel].

EZ 17:24

And all the trees of the field shall know that I, the Lord, have brought down the high tree and exalted the low tree, dried up the green tree and made the dry tree flourish; I, the Lord, have spoken and have done it.”

every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit. A good tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a bad tree bear good fruit. Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. Therefore by their fruits you will know them.

ROM 11:16-18

if the root is holy, so are the branches. And if some of the branches were broken off, and you, being a wild olive tree, were grafted in among them, and with them became a partaker of the root and fatness of the olive tree, do not boast against the branches. But if you do boast, remember that you do not support the root, but the root supports you.

MK 8:22-26

Then He put His hands on his eyes again and **made him** look up. And he was restored and saw everyone clearly.
