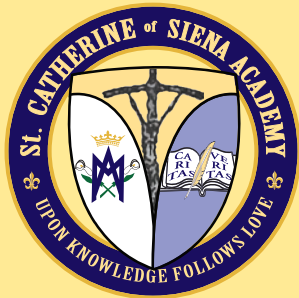

From Regionals to Records: *SCA Makes Tennis History*

SCA Tennis Makes History at State

The St. Catherine of Siena Academy Varsity Tennis Team made school history this spring with its best-ever finish at the State Tournament—fourth place overall—and the program's first individual State Champions.

After qualifying with a second-place finish at the Greenhills Regional on May 14, the Stars traveled to Midland ready to compete on the state's biggest stage. Senior Sabrina Alstott set the tone early with a hard-fought, three-set victory over her opponent from Grand Rapids North Point Christian. By the end of Day 1, four of the team's eight flights had advanced to Saturday's semifinals, with SCA sitting in fourth place and tallying 15 points—already a program-best performance.

The tournament highlights came in doubles play. #1 Doubles partners Julia Ivezaj '26 and Stephanie Lisch '26 battled through the bracket, defeating Notre Dame Prep before falling in the championship match. At #2 Doubles, freshman Loren Nafso and senior Lily Wolocko made history by winning both a Regional and State title, defeating Greenhills for the second time this season. Their victory marked the first time SCA athletes have been crowned State Champions in tennis.

While not every flight earned points, the team celebrated the significance of every match—and the unity that brought them to this milestone finish.

A Coaching Legacy

The Stars' success stems from the leadership of Head Coach and Principal Judy Hehs, who has guided the program for six years. With 38 seasons of coaching experience, Judy has built a legacy of excellence that blends elite competition with character formation. This year she was once again honored as Regional Coach of the Year, adding to an extraordinary list of accolades that includes six State Championships, 14 Regional titles, and 19 Top-10 State finishes.

Judy is quick to point out that this success is shared. Assistant Coach Don McCartney, a fixture on the staff

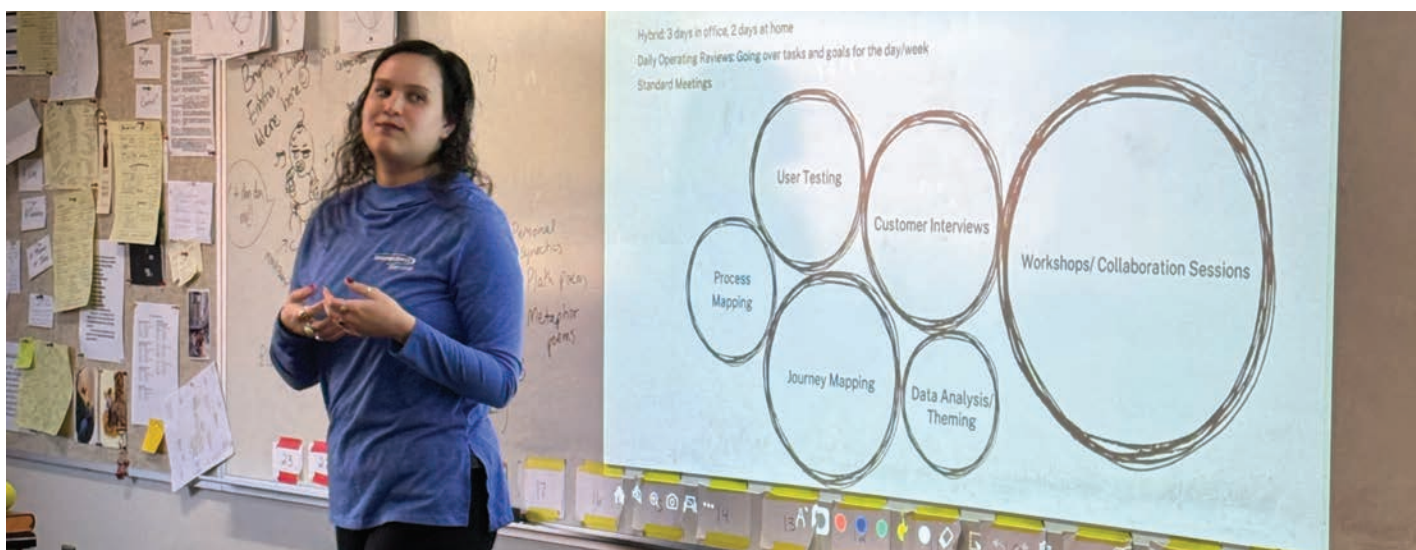
for the past four years, brings decades of coaching and teaching experience that has been a true gift to the program. Former coach Rick Hermann continues to lend his wisdom at the team's biggest tournaments, while Dean of Students Dan Bumpus stepped in at Regionals to support the players and coaching staff. Together, they represent the spirit of community that defines SCA athletics.

More than wins and titles, the coaching team instills discipline, teamwork, and faith. Their players don't just grow into stronger athletes—they grow into confident young women prepared to lead.

This spring, Kayla Sawa '19 returned to St. Catherine of Siena Academy to deliver the Commencement Address for the Class of 2025. Her words reflected not only her faith but also the remarkable journey she has taken since graduating.

Her Time at SCA

As a student, Kayla served on Student Council, was inducted into the National Honor Society, participated in CASA, and competed in lacrosse and field hockey—balancing academics, athletics, and service with grace. A senior-year mission trip to the Dominican Republic ignited a lasting passion for serving others, which she continued on trips to Nicaragua and Peru after graduation.

Academic and Professional Achievements

Kayla pursued nursing at Wayne State University through the direct admit program, earning her Bachelor of Science in Nursing in 2023. Today, she serves as a nurse, caring for others with dedication and compassion. Her creativity shines through photography and singing, and she remains active in volunteer work with youth programs.

Highlights from Her Commencement Address

Speaking to the Class of 2025, Kayla encouraged graduates to embrace their unique paths and resist the pressure of comparison or societal expectations. She reminded them that their worth comes from God's love, not grades, college admissions, or accolades.

"Know that God has you exactly where He wants you and He is with you, in everything, even if it doesn't feel like it. He has a plan for your life—a unique plan specifically for you."

Drawing on St. Thérèse of Lisieux, she added:

"Every flower has its own created beauty... If every flower wanted to be a rose, nature would lose her spring adornments and the fields would not be beautiful with their varied flowers. So it is in the world of souls, the living garden of God."

Kayla emphasized daily prayer, surrounding oneself with faithful friends, and embracing opportunities to serve. Her message to the Class of 2025 was clear: live boldly in your Catholic faith, trust God's plan, and let your light shine to inspire others.

A STAR Who Found Her Home

Celebrating Madison Wasen^{'20}

Madison's journey to SCA began when Ladywood High School closed in 2018. She found a new home at St. Catherine, where she quickly embraced sisterhood and opportunity. A multi-sport athlete in field hockey, softball, and competitive cheer, Madison discovered her true passion on the cheer mat—encouraged by her SCA coaches, Erin^{'15} and Anna^{'15}.

At SCA, she earned All-Catholic honors and was celebrated not just for her athletic talent, but for her leadership, kindness, and faith in action. Madison competed with grit and grace, leaving a lasting mark on her teammates, coaches, and the STAR community.

After graduating in 2020, Madison continued her journey at Alma College, following in the footsteps of her parents—both Alma athletes. There, she became a four-time All-American and four-time National Champion in cheer, building a legacy of excellence.

On June 9, 2025, Madison made history as the first cheerleader ever inducted into the Catholic League Hall of Fame. In her speech, she thanked SCA for giving her a home and expressed heartfelt gratitude to her coaches. The award was presented by Principal Judy Hehs, herself a CHSL Hall of Fame inductee—a full-circle moment for our STAR family.

And the celebrations didn't stop there: in September 2025, Madison was inducted into the St. Catherine of Siena Academy Hall of Fame, joining the growing tradition of alumnae, coaches, and community members who shape SCA's story.

The Hall of Fame VIP Reception and Induction Ceremony preceded the Varsity Volleyball game on September 19, 2025. This event honored Madison, as well as distinguished contributors, Mike and Mary Dewan and Damon Weaver.

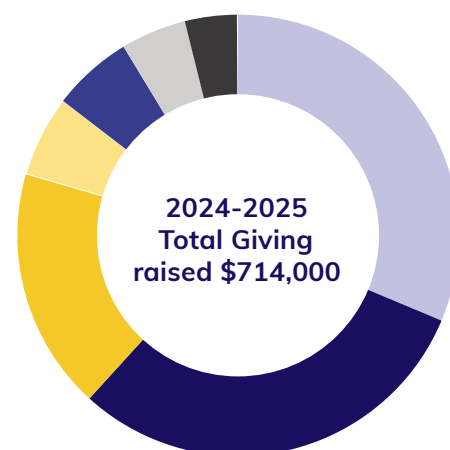

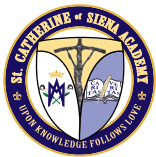
