- Abstract
- Portfolio
- Poster presentation
- PowerPoint presentation
- Video

- Digital Arts, Film & Performing Arts
- Humanities & Education
- Ministry, Service & Community Outreach

## SUBMIT YOUR PROJECT PROPOSAL BY FEB. 20

- Applications close Feb. 20

- Presentations should be 10-12 minutes in length
- Visual display is strongly encouraged
