November 2025



November carries forward the market's bullish tone.

The Indian market ended October on a strong note, driven by robust domestic growth and improving global sentiment. PSU banks and metal stocks led the rally, supported by strong Q2 earnings and rising global demand. Lower crude oil prices also boosted oil and gas companies by improving refining margins. The Bank Nifty hit a new all-time high, while the Nifty held firm above 26,000, backed by solid performance in auto and FMCG stocks. Positive cues from GST 2.0 reforms, strong festive demand and improving India-U.S. trade ties further lifted market confidence, setting a strong tone for November's momentum.

November is expected to maintain a positive tone, with investors focusing on the last leg of earnings, the conclusion of the U.S.-India tariff discussions, and the outcome of the U.S. Fed meeting. A dovish policy stance could further support FII inflows. The cool-off in gold and silver prices also signals improving risk appetite. Domestically, the rollout of GST 2.0 will be crucial for the auto and FMCG sectors, potentially driving the next leg of growth. Additionally, the upcoming Bihar elections will be closely watched — a favourable outcome for the NDA could further strengthen market sentiment. Overall, steady macro data, festive demand, and easing global headwinds point to a constructive November for Indian equities.
