The Ewelme Almshouse Charity provides independent living accommodation to individuals and couples at or over the current state retirement age. The almshouses are small, close-knit communities in historic surroundings. It is a requirement of the Charity that applicants are able to live independently as there are no care facilities on site. Each Almshouse has a sitting room, a bedroom, kitchen, and bathroom/WC and there are communal laundry facilities. Please note, some almshouses are in 15th century buildings, some have stairs and all almshouses are in rural locations so the capacity to drive is advantageous. To assure the Charity of an applicant's ability to live independently they are requested to ask their GP to complete the below Medical Questionnaire.
