The International Secondary Certificate (ISC) programme offers international students an pathway to academic success and access to tertiary studies. The ISC programme is based on a curriculum developed by the IEB and supervised by the University of Stellenbosch in South Africa (SA). It covers schooling from Grade 10 to Grade 12, ensuring a holistic and well-rounded educational experience. With a well-resourced curriculum and platform, providing a recognized qualification, the ISC programme equips students with the knowledge and skills needed for future success.



WHO IS THE ISC FOR?

Learners residing outside the borders of South Africa (e.g. expats or learners from SADC countries) who wish to obtain a South African school-leaving certificate that is accepted at South African and international universities.

The ISC is approved by USAF as a school-leaving qualification for entry into SA universities. UK ENIC recognizes the ISC's equivalency to the GCE Advanced Subsidiary level (which facilitates access to UK universities).

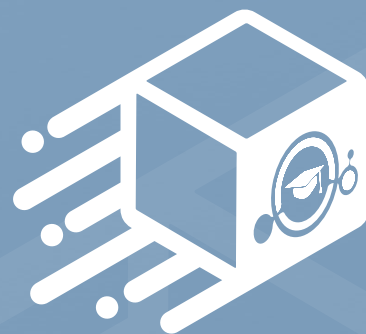

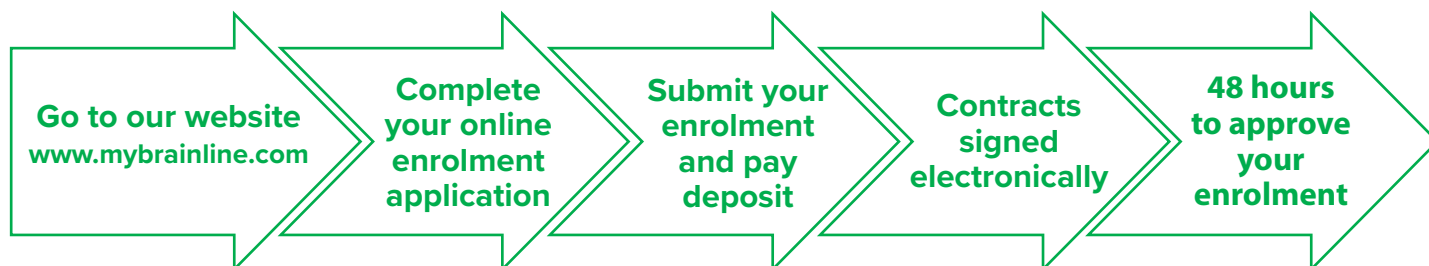
