Reflect, Adjust, Do (RAD) is a simple way to review our ministry actions in light of the MAP and be honest about how we might continue to improve.

Champion- Who is the Champion (the Accountable person) of this RAD?

Reflect- This section is focused on questions that help us see clearly how the intent, goal, and pre-event planning shaped the actual event.
