LIFE ONBOARD

The Sjourney train features 13 carriages, including 10 sleeper carriages and 2 bistro carriages, with a maximum capacity of 60 passengers per journey. Its design is heavily influenced by the Indochine style, reminiscent of the golden age of travel in the 1930s, when luxury trains like the Trans-Indochina connected different regions of Southeast Asia. This timeless aesthetic blends nostalgia with modern elegance, recreating the romance of classic train journeys while offering contemporary comforts.







CLASSIC TWIN/DOUBLE CABINS

Beautifully appointed ensuite cabins, set out with either twin beds or a double bed, allow you to relax in comfort as the charm of Vietnam unfolds beyond your window. Furnishings include a table and chairs, and storage solutions to ensure a clutter-free living space.

Daily off-train excursions are led by expert guides, exploring the culture, history and captivating landscapes you are travelling through. Immersive experiences include visits to traditional artisans and dining on local specialties, complemented by onboard activities such as cooking classes.

Highlights include exploring the spiritual Ta Cu Mountain and ancient Cham towers in Phan Thiet, witnessing traditional mat weaving and visiting the stunning Mang Lang Church in Phu Yen, and delving into the UNESCO World Heritage site of Hoi An Ancient Town with its captivating markets, historic homes, and woodblock painting workshops.

Continue to Hue to discover the Imperial Citadel and poetic Tu Duc Mausoleum before venturing into the dramatic landscapes of Quang Binh's Phong Nha-Ke Bang National Park for a boat trip through its magnificent caves. The journey concludes with a serene sampan ride through the towering limestone cliffs of Ninh Binh's Trang An, a visit to Vietnam's ancient capital of Hoa Lu, and a final arrival in the vibrant city of Hanoi.
