Second Wave rolls out



What's happening at Halifax Playhouse

A new section of Halifax Thespians is being developed to offer extra opportunities for and development of members across the range of activities related to productions.

Four times a year, **Second Wave** will present a three-evening production featuring several types of entertainment, such as one act plays – both established and new writing – script-in-hand presentations; Improv; and other creative events.

Through this programme, two key areas of member activity will be addressed. For some members, the prospect of learning a whole script's lines is too daunting, but taking part in a one-act play, or script in hand still seems possible. Thus more opportunities arise for more members.

On the other hand, there are those who want to learn more – about acting, directing and the technical side of productions. Though there are

opportunities to shadow off-stage roles in main productions, Second Wave will be able to provide entry-level help backed by the skills and knowledge of experienced members with more and dedicated time to mentor newer members.

There has been a deliberate choice to help people develop "on the job" rather than with workshops.

Second Wave will be formally launched in the autumn.

In the meantime, ideas for events in the four slots are welcome and can be sent to **averted@btinternet.com** or talked over with the steering committee of Jeanette Kendall, Keith Royston, Xander Bryan or Ian Byfield.

Now with a completely new ethos, **Second Wave** follows in the footsteps of The Green Room, Total Theatre, T-3, Playhouse S.T. and Playhouse Stageworks, which have served the organisation across the years.

Stories behind the stories

The professional life of Mark Evans, author of **Bleak Expectations** (Main stage from August 26) is steeped in almost all aspects of live and broadcast humour.

He wrote for the first madcap radio series of **Bleak Expectations** and has been involved with successive series – occasionally acting too. The play has variously been

described by critics as Dickens with a dash of Monty Python and English eccentricity at its best.

But Evans was closely involved in *Week*Ending – a satirical
Radio 4 sketch show that ran for more than 1,100 episodes, for nearly 30 years; has written extensively for the TV comedy *The*



Mitchell and Web Look; and while performing as a stand-up comic, has written for a number of other comics including Milton Jones.

In addition, he has been a producer and script editor for other tv and radio shows.

To give her the full title, Dame Agatha Mary Clarissa Christie, Lady Mallowan, DBE, wrote 66 detective novels and 14 short story collections.

She wrote *The Mirror Crack'd from Side to Side* (a phrase taken from the poem The Lady of Shallot, by Alfred Lord Tennyson) in 1962. But it was not until 2019 that the stage play - adapted by Rachel Wagstaff - had its premiere at Salisbury Playhouse before going on tour to Dublin, Cambridge and Cardiff. It had involvement by Christie's grandson, Mathew Pritchard.



Rachel Wagstaff wrote the book for the multi-award winning musical *Flowers for Mrs Harris* (Best Musical, UK Theatre Awards 2016). Her adaptation of *Birdsong* (Sebastian Faulks' novel) opened in the West End, directed by Trevor Nunn, and enjoyed four UK tours.

With Duncan Abel, she adapted Paula Hawkins' *The Girl on the Train.* For radio, she adapted Sebastian Faulks' novel *The Girl at the Lion d'Or* for a five part series for Woman's Hour on Radio Four. *Moonshadow*, the musical she co-wrote with Yusuf Islam (Cat Stevens), opened at the Royal Albert Hall in 2010.


Farewell to members

Thespian members who have died recently include Geoff Green, Kevin Brennan and Ernie Grice.

Geoff Green was an accomplished comic actor who used to induce audience humour by simply appearing on stage – including once when he was playing a serious part! He served on the Publicity Committee and led the film club which operated at the Playhouse for many years. A gathering was held after his funeral in the Studio Bar.

Kevin Brennan was a regular on stage during the 70s to the 90s, and chaired the Casting Committee for a while. He also appeared in Halifax Amateurs. His funeral was at St Mary's Catholic Church, Halifax.

Ernie Grice was a member for a number of years, notably taking charge of props with Stella Underhill. They retired to the South Coast where he died.



Curtains Up

New curtains have been installed in the Studio Bar, as the refurbishment nears its conclusion.

They replace curtains which had begun to show signs of age.

Next will be the installation of new carpet on the stage, stairs and to the bar doors.
