PASEO DEL ESTE MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 11 §

The Board of Directors of Paseo del Este Municipal Utility District No. 11 of El Paso County held a regular meeting open to the public, on September 11, 2025, at its meeting place located outside of the District at the offices of TRE & Associates, LLC, 110 Mesa Park Drive, Suite 200, El Paso, Texas and via means of telephone conference number and Zoom Videoconference. The roll was called of the directors of the Board, to-wit:

All of said persons were present, with the exception of Director Muir, thus constituting a quorum. Also present and in attendance was Erika Duran of the Paseo del Este MUDs; Maria Urbina of Hilltop Securities; Frank Ortiz of TRE & Associates; and Ty Embrey and Joe Jimenez, paralegal, of Lloyd Gosselink Rochelle & Townsend, P.C.

Nadia Ganser of TRE & Associates; Isaias Moreno of Municipal Accounts and Consulting, L.P.; Franklin Stubbs of Hunt Communities; and Angela Avila of McCall Parkhurst & Horton, LLP; participated in the meeting via Zoom Videoconference.

1. The first item on the agenda was the review and approval of the minutes of the Board meeting of August 14, 2025. Upon a motion by Director Treviño and a second by Director Quintana, the minutes of said meeting were unanimously approved.

2. The next item before the Board was to consider public comments. No persons presented themselves to speak at the meeting or via Zoom Video and telephone conference. There was no action required by the Board on this agenda item. No action was taken by the Board.

3. The next item before the Board was to call the Public Hearing on the 2025 Tax Rates for the District. Director Ruiz opened the public hearing. Mr. Embrey and Ms. Urbina discussed the components that comprise the District's tax rate and recommended that the Board adopt a tax rate of 0.7638 per one hundred dollars (\$100) of assessed valuation for the year 2025. No persons presented themselves to speak at the Public Hearing. There being no persons present

to speak at the Public Hearing on the 2025 Tax Rate for the District, the public hearing on the tax rate was closed by unanimous consent of the Board.

4. The next item before the Board was to consider and act on the Order Setting 2025 Tax Rates, a copy of which is attached as **Exhibit “A”**. After further discussion, it was moved by Director Quintana and seconded by Director Treviño that the Board adopt a tax rate of \$0.7638 for the year 2025, approve the Order Setting 2025 Tax Rates (“Order”), and that the Order reflect the following tax rates of the District: (1) debt service tax rate of \$0.4487; (2) maintenance and operation tax rate of \$0.0251, and (3) contract tax rate of \$0.2900 per one hundred dollars (\$100) of assessed valuation, for a total tax rate of \$0.7638 per one hundred dollars (\$100) of assessed valuation, which motion carried unanimously.

5. The next item before the Board was to consider and act on amending the operating budget for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025. Mr. Moreno and Mr. Embrey informed the Board that there were no amendments to the operating budget needed for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025, and therefore, no action was required by the Board on this agenda item. No action was taken by the Board.

6. The next item before the Board was to consider and act on the District’s operating budget for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026. After further discussion, it was moved by Director Quintana and seconded by Director Soto that the operating budget for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026 be approved, which motion carried unanimously. A copy of the Resolution Approving the 2025-2026 Fiscal Year Operating Budget of Paseo del Este Municipal Utility District No. 11 and adopted budget are attached as **Exhibit “B”**.

7. The next item before the Board was to consider and act on the District Information Form. Mr. Embrey informed the Board that Chapter 49 of the Water Code requires that once a District adopts its tax rate, the District must file with the real property records of El Paso County notice of the tax rate for the purpose of providing notice to a purchaser of real property in the District of the tax rate. Mr. Embrey stated that the District Information Form has been revised to reflect the 2025 tax rate components.

In addition, Mr. Embrey stated that the particular form of the Notice to Purchasers that is required to be furnished by a seller to a prospective purchaser of real property in the District is included as an exhibit (“Exhibit C”) to the District Information Form. Mr. Embrey stated that upon the Board’s approval, the District Information Form and the related exhibits, including the Notice to Purchasers Form will be filed and recorded in the real property records of El Paso County.

Following further discussion, it was moved by Director Quintana and seconded by Director Treviño that the District Information Form be approved, which motion carried unanimously. A copy of the District Information Form is attached as **Exhibit “C”**.

8. The next item before the Board consider and act on the Preliminary Official Statement and the Resolution Approving the Preliminary Official Statement, and other actions necessary or appropriate relating to the offering of the District's Third Bond Issuance for sale. Ms. Ganser and Ms. Urbina, as the District's financial advisor, provided an update and presentation to the Board with information regarding the Preliminary Official Statement, the schedule concerning the Bond sale and closing, and delivery of funds.

Upon a motion by Director Quintana and a second by Director Treviño the Board unanimously approved (1) the Preliminary Official Statement, (2) the preparation and publication of the Notice of Sale of the Bonds; (3) the Resolution Approving the Preliminary Official Statement; and (4) authorized the District's Financial Advisor, General Counsel and Bond Counsel to take all actions necessary or appropriate related to the offering of the District's Third Bond Issuance for sale.

9. The next item before the Board was to consider the General Manager's Report and take action regarding the following items:

- a. Monthly report;
- b. Billing;
- c. District facility site;
- d. Pond maintenance;
- e. Landscape maintenance, including landscape maintenance acceptances;
- f. Trucks, equipment and materials purchasing;
- g. Insurance;
- h. Personnel; and
- i. Other matters.

Ms. Duran next presented the General Manager's report, a copy of which is attached as **Exhibit "D"**. Ms. Duran reported that as of the end of July the District had 426 total connections, and that seven (7) new connections were added during the current month. Ms. Duran provided the Board with a brief summary of the activities for July on the following: (1) an update of activities and improvements to the District's distribution system; (2) an update on the population and occupancy rates during the current month; (3) an update on the billing activity and number of delinquent accounts during the current month; and, (4) an update on the latest construction and maintenance activity within the Paseo del Este community and growth trends for the Paseo del Este MUD No. 11.

10. Mr. Ortiz next presented the engineer's report and updated the Board on the status of development activity within the District and the Paseo del Este community.

Mr. Ortiz next presented the following item for the Board consideration and approval:

Emerald Estates Unit Six
Drainage, Water & Wastewater Improvements
TRE No.: 1502-12122-35
Pay Estimate No. 1 from El Paso Underground Construction, Inc. - \$99,927.00.

Upon a motion by Director Treviño and a second by Director Quintana, the Board unanimously approved the processing of Pay Estimate No. 1, attached hereto as **Exhibit "E"**, in the amount of \$99,927.00 from El Paso Underground Construction, Inc.

11. Mr. Stubbs next presented the engineer's report and updated the Board on the status of development activity within the District and the Paseo del Este community.

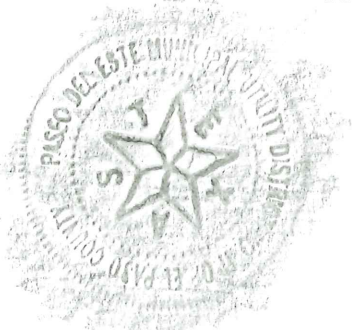

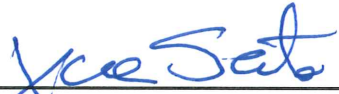
13. There was no general counsel's report.
