PASEO DEL ESTE MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 11 §

The Board of Directors of Paseo del Este Municipal Utility District No. 11 of El Paso County held a regular meeting open to the public, on May 14, 2026, at its meeting place located outside of the District at the offices of TRE & Associates, LLC, 110 Mesa Park Drive, Suite 200, El Paso, Texas and via means of telephone conference number and Zoom Videoconference. The roll was called of the directors of the Board, to-wit:

All of said persons were present, with the exception of Director Treviño, thus constituting a quorum. Also present and in attendance were Joshua Garcia of the Paseo del Este MUDs; and Frank Ortiz of TRE & Associates.

Franklin Stubbs of Hunt Communities; Isaias Moreno of Municipal Accounts and Consulting, L.P.; and Ty Embrey and Joe Jimenez, paralegal, of Lloyd Gosselink Rochelle & Townsend, P.C. participated in the meeting via Zoom Videoconference.

1. The first item on the agenda was the review and approval of the minutes of the Board meeting of April 9, 2026. Upon a motion by Director Muir and a second by Director Soto, the minutes of said meeting were unanimously approved.

2. The next item before the Board was to consider public comments. No persons presented themselves to speak at the meeting or via Zoom Video and telephone conference. There was no action required by the Board on this agenda item. No action was taken by the Board.

3. The next item before the Board was to consider the General Manager's Report and take action regarding the following items:

- a. Monthly report;
- b. Billing;
- c. District facility site;
- d. Pond maintenance;

- e. Landscape maintenance, including landscape maintenance acceptances;
- f. Trucks, equipment and materials purchasing;
- g. Insurance;
- h. Personnel; and
- i. Other matters.

Mr. Garcia provided updates on the following items listed above.

District facility site: Mr. Garcia informed the Board that construction of the office building should be completed by August 16, 2026.

Pond and Landscape maintenance: Mr. Garcia informed the Board that maintenance activity of ponds and landscape areas, including weed control, is on schedule.

Personnel: Mr. Garcia informed the Board that the pond and landscape maintenance is being handled in-house. Mr. Garcia noted that the Paseo del Este MUDs currently have 31 employees on staff and expect to add nine more employees this year.

Mr. Garcia next presented the General Manager's report, a copy of which is attached as **Exhibit "A"**. Mr. Garcia reported that as of the end of March the District had 469 total connections, and that four new connections were added during the current month. Mr. Garcia provided the Board with a brief summary of the activities for March on the following: (1) an update of activities and improvements to the District's distribution system; (2) an update on the population and occupancy rates during the current month; (3) an update on the billing activity and number of delinquent accounts during the current month; and, (4) an update on the latest construction and maintenance activity within the Paseo del Este community and growth trends for the Paseo del Este MUD No. 11.

4. Mr. Ortiz next presented the engineer's report and updated the Board on the status of development activity within the District and the Paseo del Este community.

5. Mr. Stubbs next presented the developer's report and updated the Board on the status of development activity within the District and the Paseo del Este community.

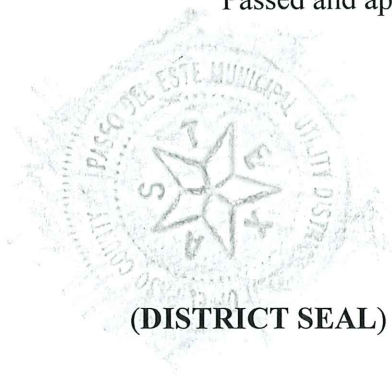
