A NOTE FROM PASTOR MARK

The story of Transform Church is a story that only God could have written! There are so many variables, twists and turns that point us to the providential hand of God behind the scenes. God is adding to our numbers at an incredible rate. In fact, over 60% of our church is new within the last two years! Not only are more and more people coming to church but they are finding spiritual growth, lasting friendships, and a family that they never knew before.

When we reached an agreement with Prairie Oak Community Church to purchase the building in the fall of 2022, we knew we would eventually outgrow the space and have to add on. I told our church (about 400 people at the time) that once we filled two services and

moved to three, we would begin to look at expanding the building. What no one predicted was that it would take us less than 18 months to get to that point!

If we want to continue to provide space for deepening relationships and have room for more people in our community to hear about a life-changing relationship with Jesus, now is the time for us to act. We are going to step by faith into the future by launching the Deep and Wide campaign.



HEART BEHIND DEEP & WIDE

Since the beginning, one of our values has been to be simultaneously deep and wide. Some churches are good at being deep—they have solid theology, they teach the Bible and the people have deep and lasting relationships with each other.

There are also churches that are good at being wide—they do evangelism well, they reach unbelievers and unchurched people successfully and grow large because of this emphasis.

At Transform, our commitment to being simultaneously deep and wide has never been stronger. Deep community, deep teaching and deep discipleship drives us to stay wide and to reach more people for Christ because Jesus said “The Son of Man came to seek and save the lost.” (Luke 19:10)

2019

June

We begin forming a launch team, but we lack a meeting space.

October

Oak View Middle School becomes available for rent, and Transform Church officially launches.

2020

March

COVID-19 forces us online.

June

We hold outdoor services at Sunshine Park.

September

After six months, we meet at Prairie Oak Community Church.

2022

September

The Nazarene denomination agrees to sell the 23,000 sq. ft. building on 34 acres for \$2.35M.

November

Our Welcome Home Campaign raises \$670,000, enabling us to close and remodel the building.

2023

January

We receive the keys and start decluttering and remodeling.

December

Construction is completed, thanks to generous donors and nearly 100 volunteers.

2024

April

After 14 months, we expand to three services as God continues to draw people to Transform Church.

October

We pay cash to expand the parking lot from 120 to 260 spots to accommodate growth.

2025

March

We publically launch the Deep & Wide capital campaign.

May

We plant our first church, Destination, in East Bethel sending 40 people.

October

Our groundbreaking ceremony includes worship, prayer, and dedication.





WHY WE CAN'T STAY WHERE WE ARE

Although we always hoped that God would move in such a way that we would have to add on to our building, we didn't think it would come this fast!

Based on consistent growth year over year, we are out of room in two of our three services and will need to add space or add a service by the end of 2026 with over 1,000 people consistently attending.

Challenge 1

Moving to four services doesn't help us significantly because service times end up being difficult (very early or very late Sunday mornings). This leaves the middle services overcrowded and turning people away.

Challenge 3

Our current setup limits community building. As service times spread out, our cafe/lobby will become too crowded, causing people to leave quickly rather than connect.

Challenge 5

Our kids' wing is overflowing with young children! Without more space, class sizes will become too large, leading us to turn kids away and causing us to lose teachers due to the overwhelming environment.

Challenge 2

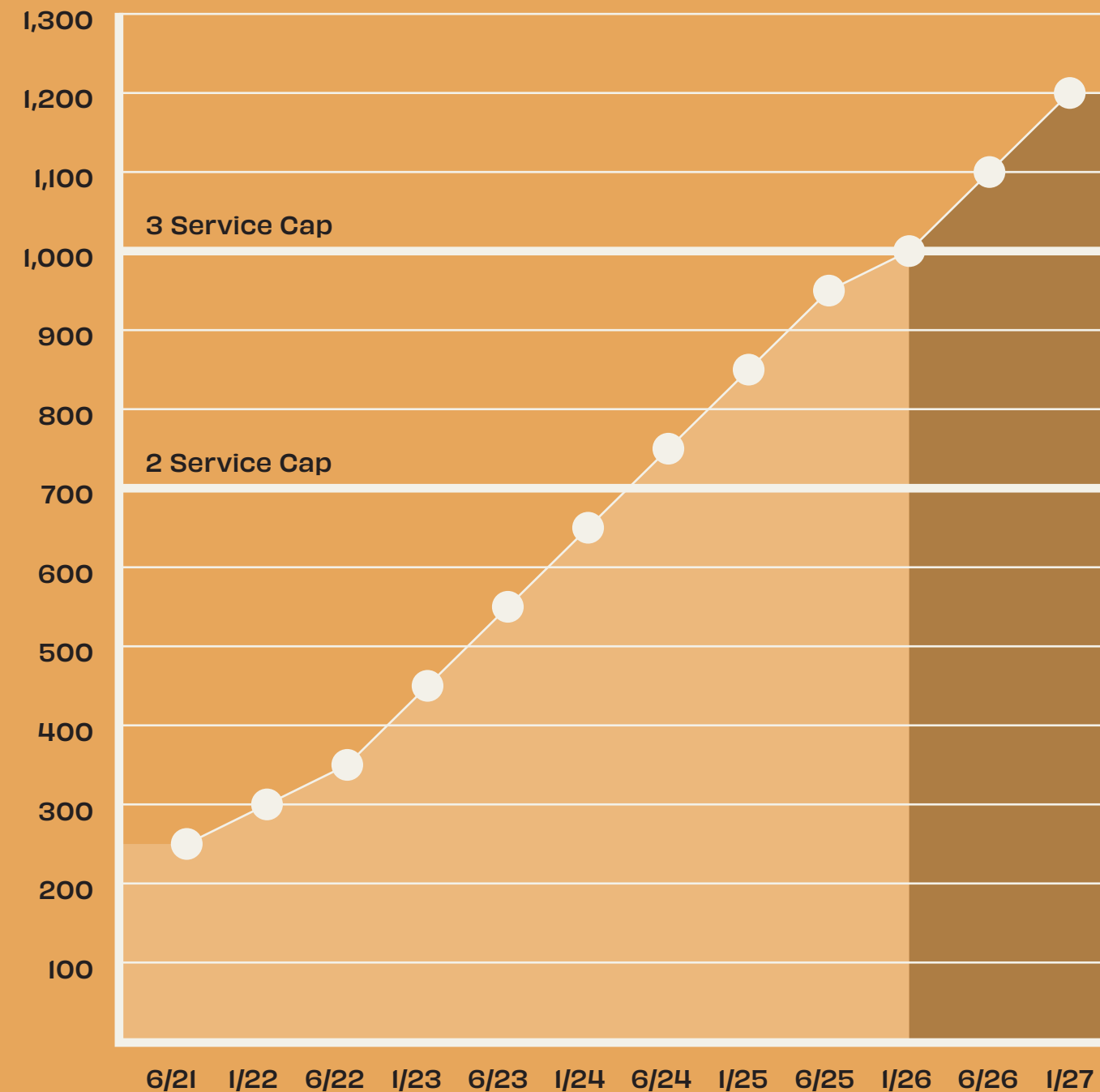
Evening services are tough on staff and volunteers. Most churches have cut these services recently, and adding more without expanding our building could lead to burnout.

Challenge 4

Our student ministry has doubled, and as many elementary kids transition to middle school, they need dedicated space for building friendships with peers and adult leaders.

Challenge 6

As Transform grows, so do our ministry needs. We've added staff to serve our church, but our offices are full and located within the secure kids wing on Sundays. A new office area frees up safe space for kids and continued staff growth.



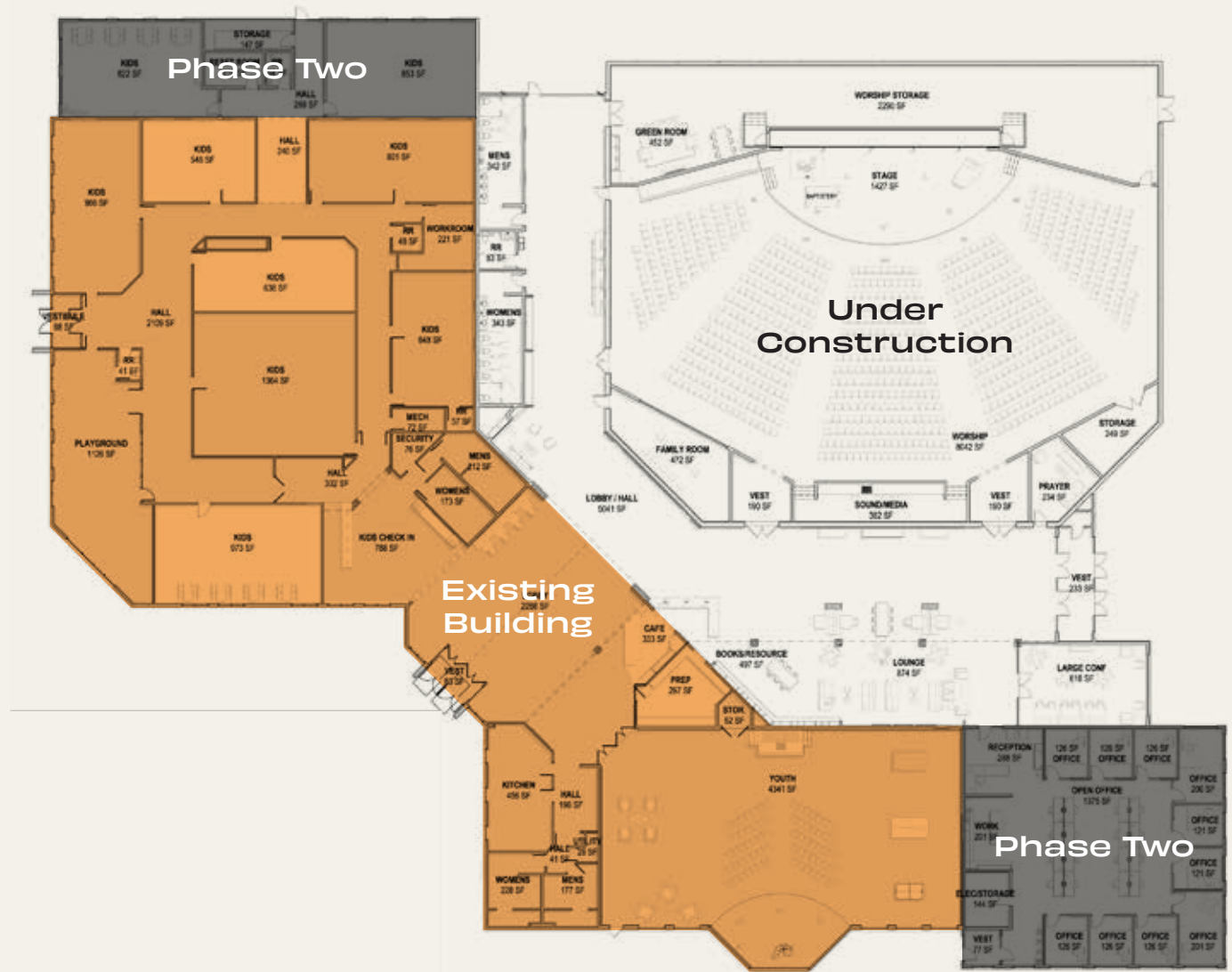
OUR TURN

We often say at Transform, “What we’re doing here isn’t new, it’s just our turn.” God has given us incredible favor in our short history. And yet, there is so much more to do.

FLOORPLAN

The needed additional space will expand our building from 23,000 to 52,000 square feet, allowing us to grow both deep and wide. This expansion is not just about increasing our square footage; it's about creating a welcoming environment that meets our ever changing needs.



LOBBY

It's no secret that Transform members love to linger and connect! Our new lobby, café, and seating areas will offer three times the current space, enhancing our ability to gather before and after services.



WORSHIP

Our new worship center will boost seating capacity from 300 up to a max of 800. With a flat floor design, it will be versatile for banquets and conferences. Every seat is arranged for close views of the stage, eliminating the need for live video.





KIDS

For many Transform families, it's the kids bringing their parents to church! To keep class sizes small, we'll add four new classrooms for birth to 5th grade, along with two new kids' bathrooms for safety and functionality. These classrooms are part of Phase Two.



YOUTH

In many larger churches, youth meet in a massive worship center on Wednesdays but are often overlooked on Sundays. We're dedicating our 4,300 square foot worship center to youth as their permanent space, fostering deep friendships between Sunday services and Wednesday youth group.

THE COST

The Transform Church building team (staff and volunteers) worked with our architects (Thielen & Green) and our general contractor (Kinghorn Construction) to address all the needs that Transform is currently facing.

Our total construction price for the **29,000 square foot** addition is **7.2 million dollars**.

As of early 2026, **over 3 million dollars** has already been pledged through the Deep and Wide campaign with 45% given to date!

Through cost savings and generous material and labor donations in this phase of the project, we have revised our goal for the people of Transform to raise an additional

\$500,000 over the remaining 24 months of the campaign. This will position us to build the kids and office wings in 2027, purchase the audio and video equipment for the new worship center, and furnish the lobby and café spaces this year.

We have worked hard to design a building that will look great but will also be something our future budget can afford. If this is going to happen, God will have to move through us. He has been so faithful to Transform in the past six years and we believe this is the next step of His plan for us.

We are asking everyone who calls Transform Church home to give sacrificially towards Deep & Wide.

WHAT CAN I DO

Pray

The most important thing you can do is pray. Pray for your church. Pray for our future. Pray about your role in the Deep & Wide campaign. This is a spiritual decision, not a financial one.

Talk

If you're married, begin to talk it over with your spouse. After each of you have prayed about it, share what number you feel God is leading you to give.

Pledge

After prayerfully considering, come to a decision as to how you want to make a financial impact over two years and turn in your pledge card.





HOW IS THIS POSSIBLE?

How is it going to be possible for our church to raise an additional **\$500,000** over two years alongside our current Deep and Wide campaign and our normal general fund giving? Wisdom and experience tell us we will need gift commitments like these to be successful. We aim for equal sacrifice, not equal giving. Every gift and every giver makes a difference!

QUESTIONS YOU MIGHT BE ASKING

When are audio and video furnishing funds needed?

Our new worship center is scheduled for completion in November 2026. In the final months of construction, our audio/video contractor will work alongside the general contractor to install lighting, sound, and video systems—speakers, soundboard, cameras, screens, and projectors—throughout the building. This is a significant investment, and we must have these funds secured by fall 2026 so everything is installed and ready when the building is complete.

When can we break ground on Phase Two?

Once construction is complete and we have occupancy of the new worship center, café, lobby, and conference space, we will shift focus to the additional kids areas and office buildout. As Deep & Wide campaign funds continue to come in throughout 2027, we will break ground once we are confident we have the resources needed to complete those spaces. We anticipate this happening toward the end of 2027, about one year after the worship center opens.

Why do we need to raise additional funds now?

In 2025, we reduced the plan to a Phase One and Phase Two approach after raising \$3M of the original \$4M goal. Phase One includes the new worship center and commons, but furnishings and essential A/V equipment still need funding. Continued giving will allow us to begin Phase Two soon after Phase One is complete. Raising an additional \$500,000 now will fully equip the worship center this year and position us to break ground on Phase Two in 2027.

Why don't we just save up the funds?

Even if we redirected \$100,000 each year—a substantial commitment—from our regular budget, it would take five years to fully complete both Phase One and Phase Two. With construction already underway, we need to carry Phase One to completion while planning ahead for Phase Two. Our kids and staff are already feeling space constraints, but we will not break ground until the required funds are committed, so we don't incur additional debt.
